ASSIGNMENT AND DEADLINES

Congratulations on starting your ancient Roman research paper. All deadlines are at the START of class, unless marked with an asterisk (*).

ASSIGNMENT	DUE DATE	DESCRIPTION
topic selection	Wednesday, 4/15	Narrow down a topic from one of the 6 themes. Complete the topic selection sheet.
preliminary outline	Friday, 4/17*	Create an outline that can guide your research following the guidelines in the outline handout. Should have at least 5 Roman numerals representing each paragraph of the paper. This will change as you do research and write your paper.
initial card check	Tuesday, 4/28*	Quick check that you have at least 10 completed note cards and 2 bibliography cards. They need to be formatted correctly! This can be turned in in advance if you are ready to be checked early.
notes complete	Friday, 5/8*	All 20 (or more) note cards and all 4 bibliography cards are complete and formatted correctly. At least one of your bibliography cards is for a book. You are prepared to start writing and have finished doing research.
body paragraph draft	Tuesday, 5/12	Complete one body paragraph and checked for spelling, grammar, and understanding. This can be any body paragraph for your paper. It must include in-text citations.
intro paragraph draft	Thursday, 5/14	Complete an introduction paragraph following the guidelines in the introduction handout.
conclusion paragraph draft	Monday, 5/18	Complete a conclusion paragraph following the guidelines in the introduction handout.
complete rough draft	Wednesday, 5/20	Write a complete rough draft for your paper and check for spelling, grammar, and understanding.
final paper and outline	Friday, 5/22	Type a complete <u>final draft</u> that has no spelling or grammar errors and includes all in-text citations. A complete and correctly formatted <u>bibliography</u> and <u>outline</u> must be included.
