Sample: The Knesset

The Israeli parliament, located in West Jerusalem. The Knesset is responsible for passing laws in Israel and is a symbol of the Israeli government. Its location in West Jerusalem is one source of conflict over control of the city because its location in the city of Jerusalem supports the Israeli government’s claim that Jerusalem is the capital of Israel.
