Achievement	Being successful; accomplishing one's goals; being highly skilled.
Adventure/ Excitement	Doing things that involve excitement or daring; doing things that are different and/or unusual.
Appearance	Looking your best; being attractive to others.
Career/Work	Having a career you enjoy; advancing in your career; being successful in your work.
Creativity	Being creative and/or artistic; using your imagination; being able to express your uniqueness.
Education	Having or getting a good education; doing well in school; being intelligent.
Fairness/Equality	Treating all people fairly and equally; accepting differences; working to see that others' rights are not violated.
Family	Spending time with family; being close to your family.
Financial Security	Having enough money; doing well financially; being financially secure.
Friendship	Spending time with friends; having close friends; being a good friend; helping and supporting your friends; maintaining friendships over time
Having Fun	Being able to do things that are enjoyable to you; participating in recreational activities; having a good time.
Health	Having good health; keeping in good shape; being physically fit.
Honesty	Telling the truth; being open with others; being yourself; not hiding the truth or hiding from the truth; not putting on an act.
Independence	Having freedom to make your own decisions; being able to do things the way you want to; being able to do things for yourself without having to depend on others.

Integrity	Doing the right thing because it is right; standing up for what is right.

Power	Having influence over others; being looked up to by others; being in charge; being in control; being seen as strong and influential.
Religion	Serving God or a Supreme Being; living according to your religious beliefs.
Respect	Being respected by others; being treated with respect.
Service to Others	Helping others; making the world a better place; using your ability to help other people.
Social Acceptance	Being well-liked by others; having many friends; being popular.
Wisdom	Having knowledge and good judgment; making good decisions.
