*May I be heard, let him be heard.*

*I should have been heard, he would have been heard.*

IMPERATIVE.

Pres. audire, be thou heard;	audimini, be ye heard.
Fut. auditor, thou shalt be heard,	
auditor, he shall be heard;	audiuntor, they shall be heard.

INFINITIVE.

Pres. audiri, to be heard.
Perf. auditus esse, to have been heard.
Fut. auditum iri, to be about to be heard.

PARTICIPLE.

Perfect. auditus, heard, having been heard.
Gerundive. audiendus, to be heard, deserving to be heard.
