2. Type your responses to the following questions after reading chapter 1 in your American Pageant textbook.
  - a. Describe the importance and impact of agriculture on the natives living in the Americas.
  - b. Choose one of the trade routes shown on the map on page 12. Investigate/research more about that particular route. What specific goods were moved along that route? What cities developed along that route? What were the beginning and ending points of the route?
  - c. Explain fully the short and long term impact of the

Columbian Exchange on both the Old and New Worlds.

- d. How does Zinn's depiction of the discovery of the Americas compare to Kennedy's (as told in Pageant)?

Reminders: When responding to these questions, answers must be in full sentences. You must provide plenty of supporting information. Answers must be your own, not a regurgitation of the text, but your interpretation. Ideas taken directly from the text should have a page number internally cited. For letter b. internet cites may be cited with url only, for letter d. cite (Zinn 9) or (Kennedy 9) so that I can clearly determine which book you are citing from.

You will place your work in a file, that I will create on the wiki. I'm in the process of figuring this out now. I will post directions for this once I figure it out myself :) Please make sure you include a full heading: First and Last name, Date, Assignment on your paper.
