Google Apps/Docs are free but lack many features found in Office 2007 and 2010. When given the choice our users always pick Office over Docs. I gave users the choice of Open Office and 2007 and no one liked Open Office. Office 2010 and Office Web apps are a natural extension of Office 2007. To change from MS office would be a major retraining transition for everyone in our school. When we can get an Office license for \$30 after aid the meager cost savings could not justify the retraining and loss of functionality. Office Web Apps will be free so it will be interesting to see where they fit into the mix and stack up with the Google offerings. If we had to pay the full license price of about \$170 for each Office license with no aid we would probably be seriously looking at an alternative. We are a Google Apps for Education district but the main use is for email, on line storage, and other tools; use of the online office tools has never taken off.
