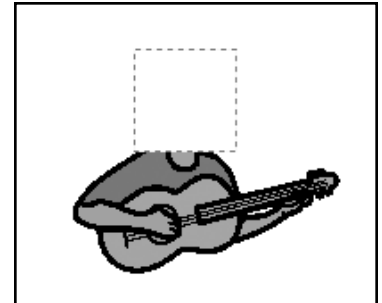


Creating Invisible Buttons

1

Draw cell around portion of symbol

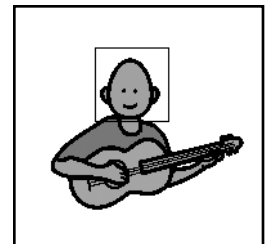
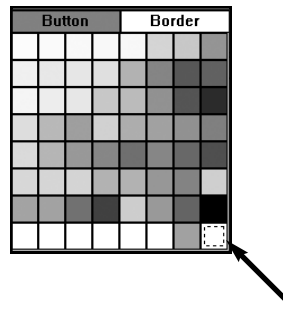
- Select the portion of the symbol that you want to have an invisible button and **draw a cell**.
- Remove label and place on background of board.



2

Make cell transparent

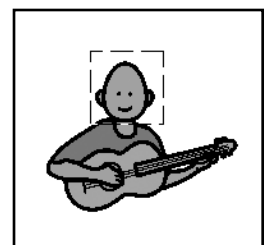
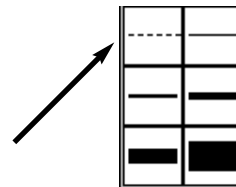
- Select new cell.
- Go to **Color Tool** and select the last square (it has a dotted border).
- The picture should now show through.

Make borders invisible

- Select new cell.
- Go to **Line Thickness** and select the invisible line (it is represented by a dotted line).
- Please note: This line will appear dotted on your screen but in use mode (or printed) it will be invisible.**

Program Cell

- Double click on the now invisible button.
- Program this cell with whatever actions you would like it to have.
- Go to Use Mode to try it out!
