

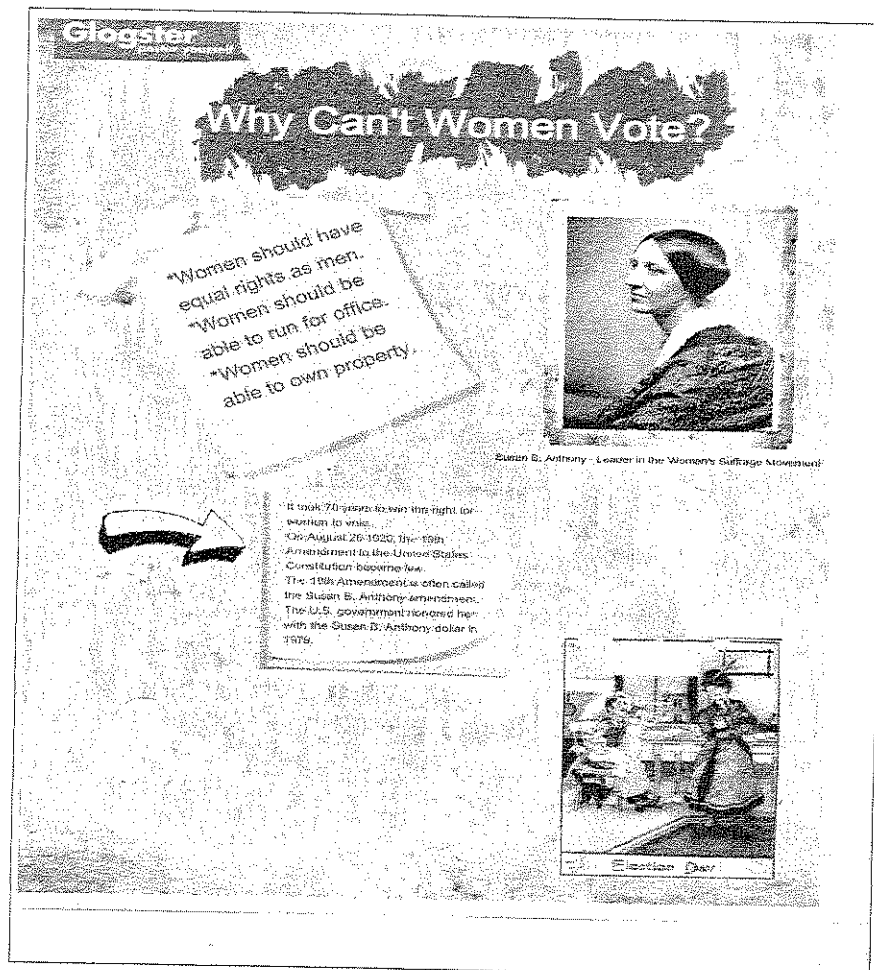
Glogster

Students can create electronic posters to present a report on a topic. The posters can include audio clips, video clips and links, in addition to images and text. The images can be photos, graphics or drawings. Glogster Edu allows teachers to setup private classes and significantly limits the questionable social networking features of the original Glogster.

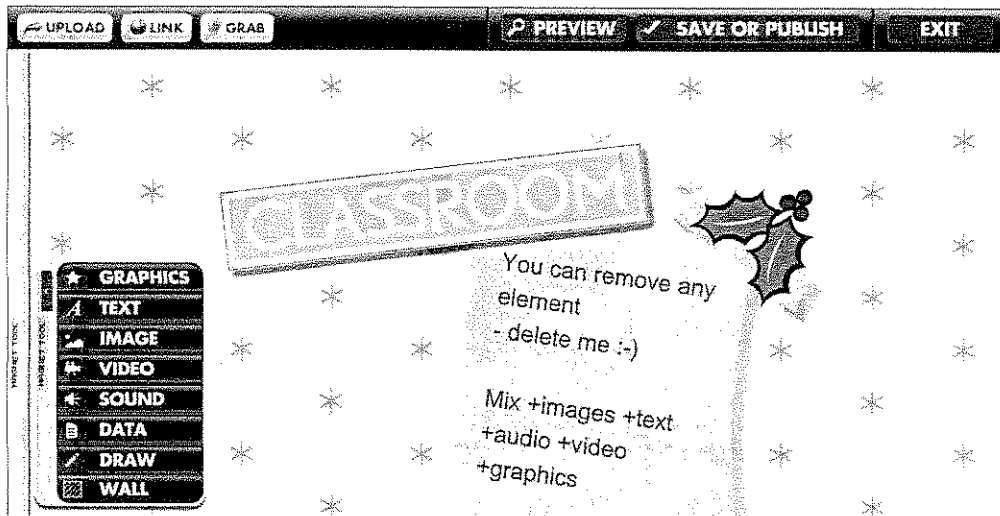

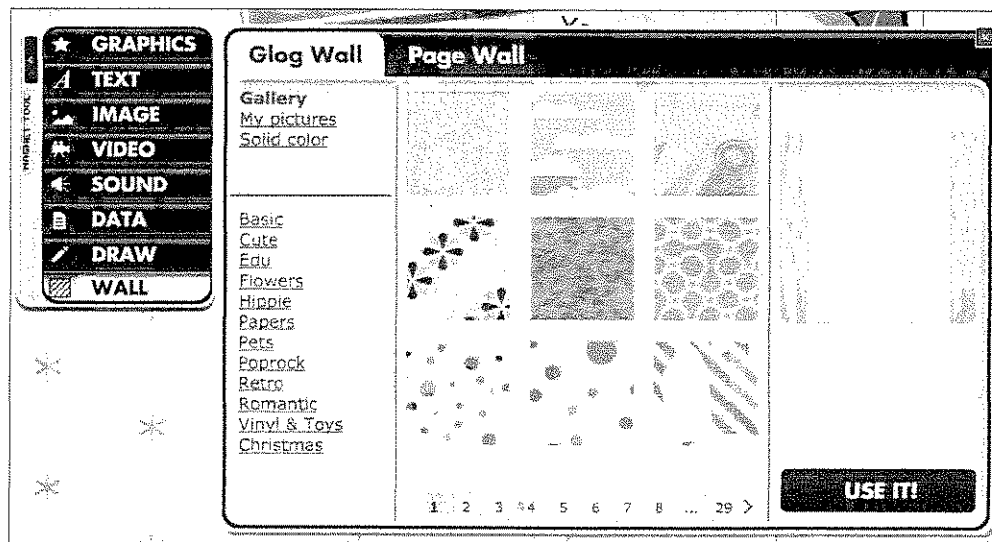


How Do I Create It?

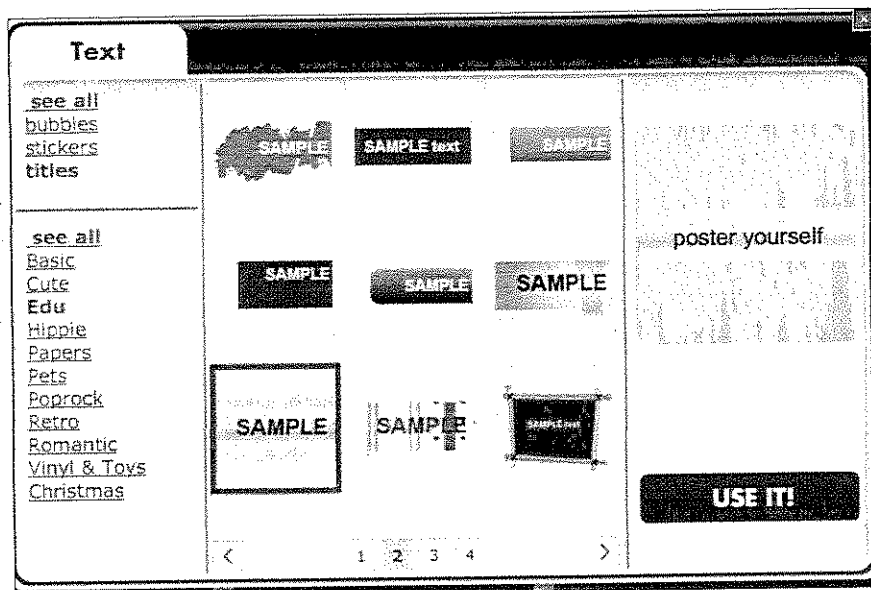
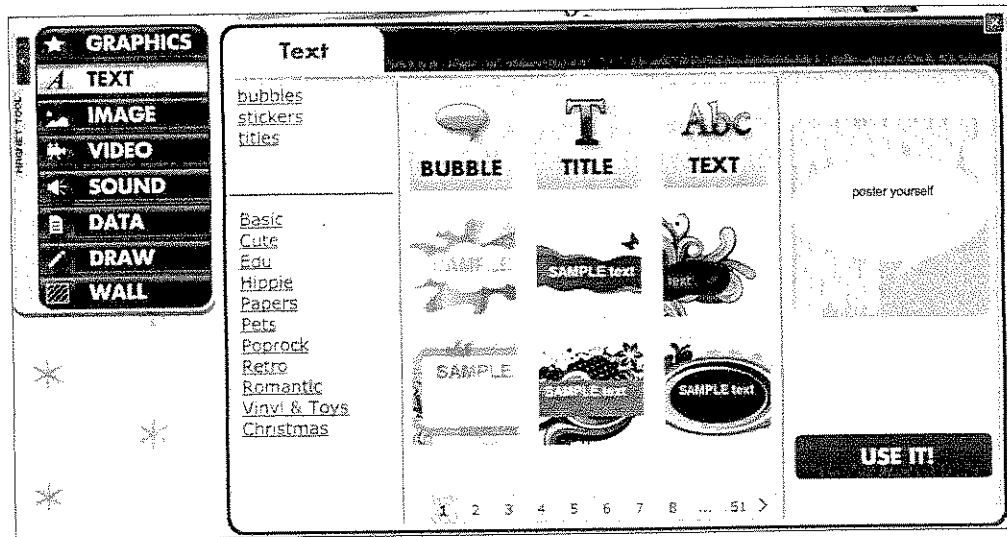
1. On the opening screen, you see the basic tools that you use to create your interactive poster.



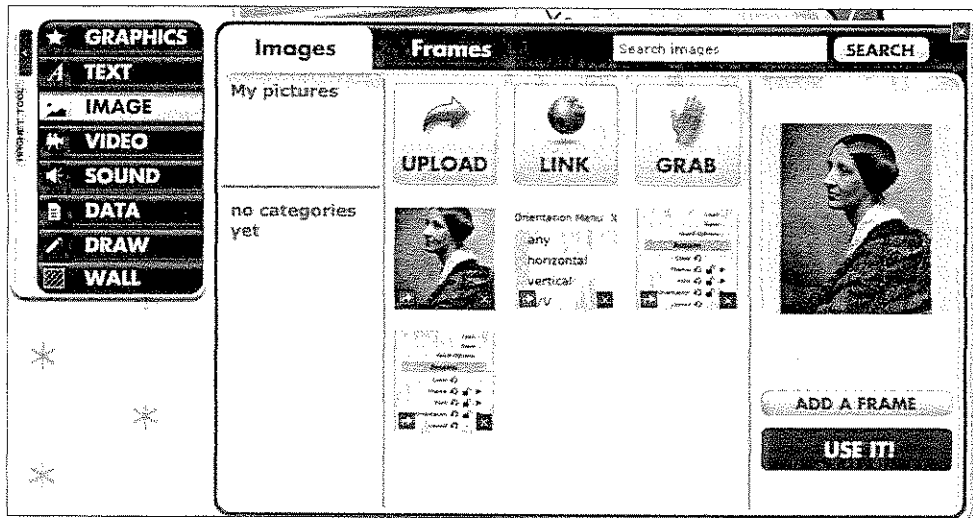
2. The Wall is the background color. Selecting it first allows you to see how the other elements will show up. It can be edited to change colors at any point.
3. There may be numerous screens for you to scroll through to make a selection.
4. Each time you make a selection in any of the menus, it gives you a preview, and may offer additional choices. If you like the wall, all you have to do is click on Use It.



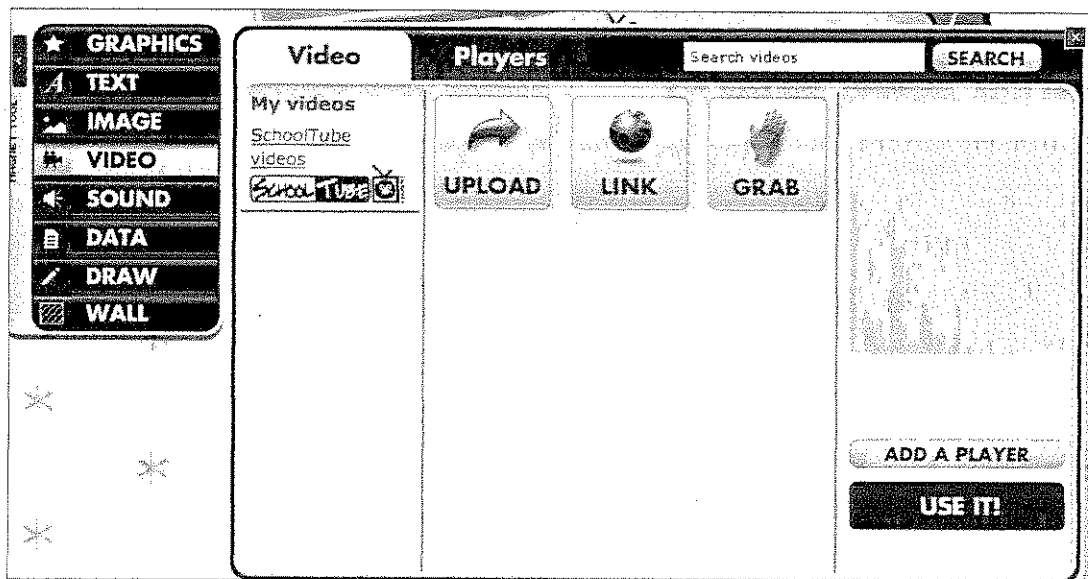
5. Text choices are Bubble, Title or Text.
6. Each can be edited for color, font, centering and adding links.



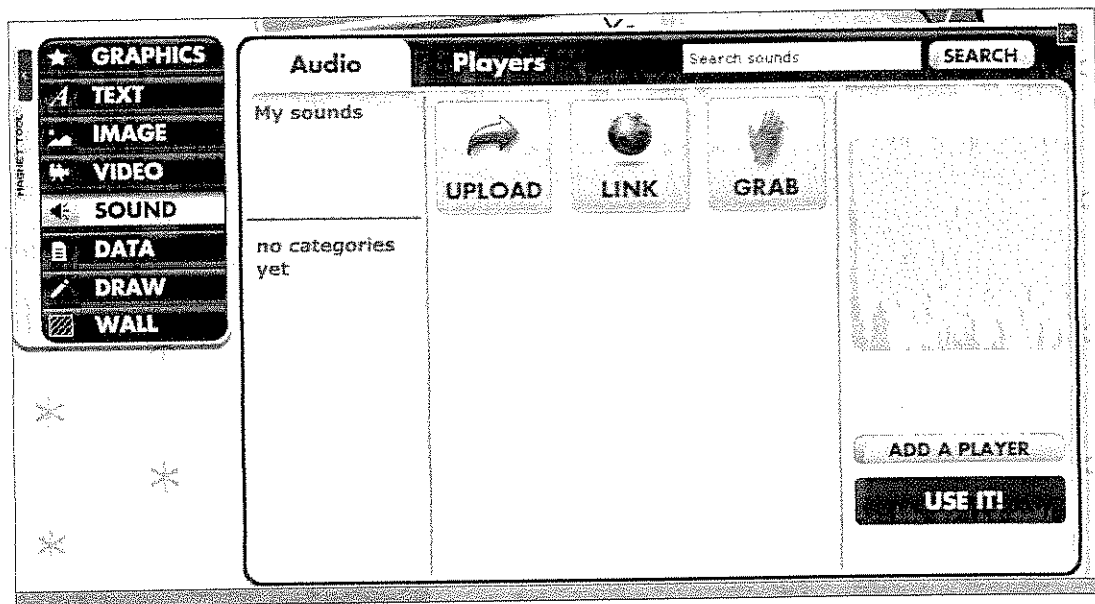
7. Images can be uploaded, linked to or you just grab one.



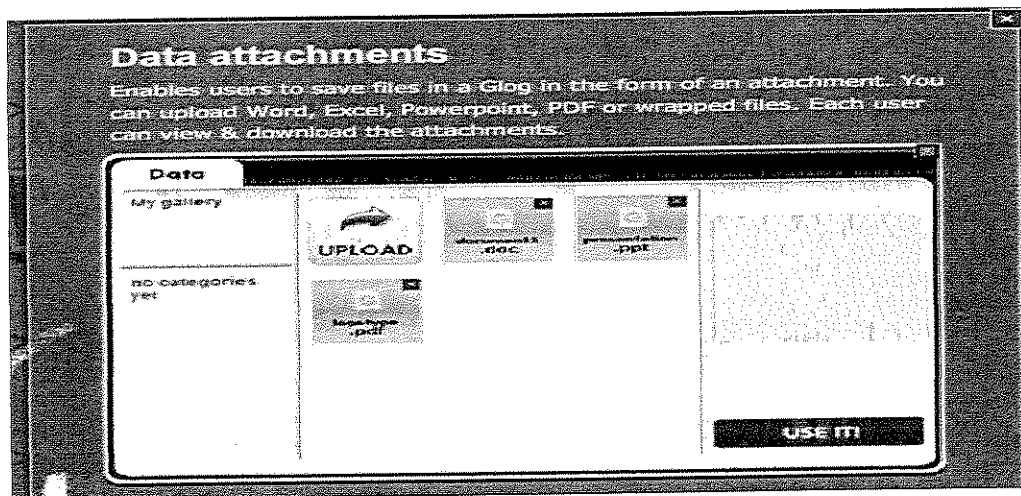
8. A video may be created by the student and uploaded, linked to or made into a SchoolTube video.



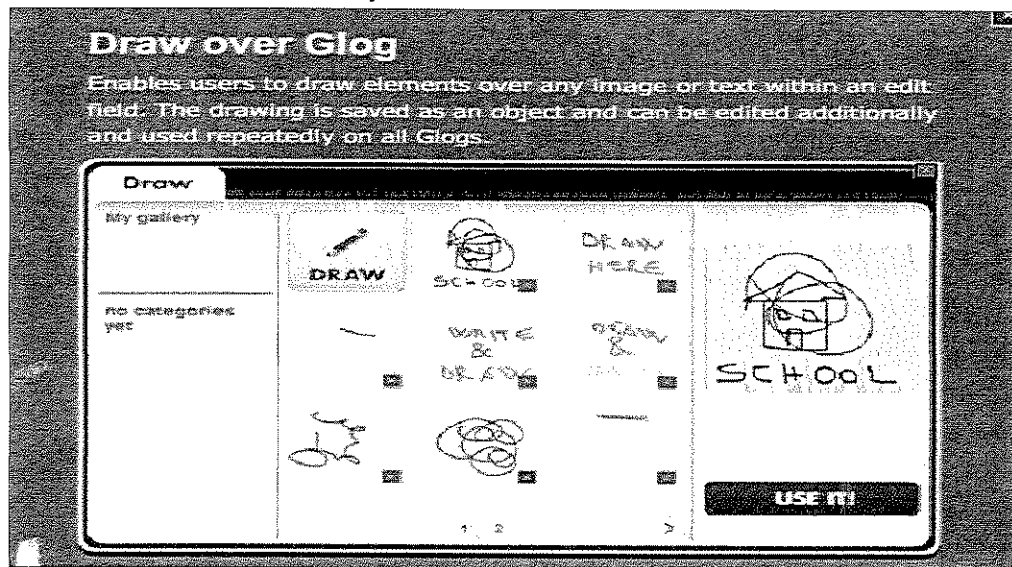
9. Students can do their own narration, link to an appropriate URL and/or a music file that has been uploaded.



10. Students can upload other files as an attachment.



11. Students can add their own annotations or drawings. The drawings can be edited and saved as an object.



12. Graphics can be added at any time. Often it is better to allow students to do that after the other information has been entered. Some of the graphics are animated.

What Else Can I Do?

- Students can create biographies of famous people, book reviews, science fair projects, or any interactive report.
- Collaborative projects can be setup in Glogster.
- Teachers using the free Educational Glogster account can have 50 student accounts.
- Teachers can share projects with each other at the school level allowing cross-curricular projects to be designed.
