Applicants must reinforce the characteristics and commitment that Chuck Cicconetti had toward the community to include leadership roles in academic, athletic, community, and/or part-time employment activities. Home schooled student applications will also be accepted.

This scholarship is for one year and applicants and/or recipients may not re-apply.
