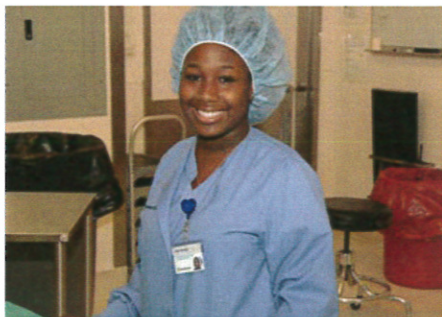


Health Horizons Internship Program
