

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR WAYNE COUNTY COUNSELORS ASSOCIATION

SCHOLARSHIP IN MEMORY OF KENNETH BLACK

GUIDELINES:

1. Give out one (1) scholarship annually.
2. Amount to be determined each year by available funds.
3. Limit each school to one or two high school senior nominees.
4. At least one counselor in high school must be member of (WCCA) and active in organization, to submit nominations.
5. Nominees must pursue a Career in Education (K-12). The candidate must be accepted by the college or university of his/her choice as a full-time student.
6. Academic qualifications to be primary basis of selection. Financial need to be used only as basis of selection among equally qualified nominees.
7. High School **transcript** and **resume** should be attached that includes PSAT, SAT, or ACT test scores.
8. Selection committee composed of volunteers from WCCA membership.
9. Scholarship money will be paid directly to the student, upon proof of enrollment.

TIME SCHEDULE:

- A. Applications available in February from your high school counselor.
- B. Applications must be submitted to the high school guidance counselor by **March 17th, 2014.**
- C. The high school counselor will submit one or two applications to WCCA treasurer by **March 24, 2014.**
- D. Selection of the recipient will be made by the selection committee.
- E. Presentation of Award will be made by current chairperson of selection committee or President of the WCCA. The guidance counselor at the recipient's high school will determine time and location of the presentation of the award.
