

Lincoln Way Scott Schleappi Scholarship

Lincoln Way sixth graders have been raising funds for a sixth grade trip for over thirty years. Around 1998 the sixth grade trip had a carry over of eighteen thousand dollars. The principal and two sixth grade teachers decided to use some of the carry over monies to fund a scholarship for graduating seniors who attended Lincoln Way. We began awarding students two hundred and fifty dollars scholarships in 1999. Then in 2003, an active Lincoln Way parent and PTO member, Scott Schleappi, passed away from cancer and a memorial fund was established to help fund the Lincoln Way Scholarship. Mr. Schleappi's name was then added to the scholarship. Lincoln Way closed in 2012 and the balance (ten thousand dollars) in the sixth grade trip/scholarship fund was dedicated to providing scholarships to former Lincoln Way students in the amount of five hundred dollars per scholarship.
