Darl W. Brooks was born on November 15, 1964. He was raised in Wooster, Ohio and was the youngest of five children. He is survived by his parents, Dana and Virginia Brooks, his three sisters, Denise Retherford, Deann Markle and Danette Bartholomew, and one brother, Dana Brooks II. He was a 1982 graduate of Triway High School with a 3.905 GPA of which was fifth in his class of 162 students. By the end of his sophomore year, he had taken all the math classes available at the high school level. During his junior and senior years of high school he completed 17.5 semester hours of math courses at The College of Wooster. Darl's senior year he finished third in the State of Ohio in the USA Math Olympiad test out of 29,000 participating students. He was a member of the golf team and lettered as a sophomore, junior and senior. He also lettered in baseball his senior year.

Darl graduated from Miami University in May 1986 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Mathematics with a minor in Statistics. He also earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Systems Analysis with a special interest in accounting.

Darl had many interests including softball, basketball, golf, bridge, pool, darts, chess, backgammon and music. He was an NFL football fan with his favorite team being the Oakland Raiders. He was on The First Church of God Bible Quiz Team in 1982 when his team won the National Tournament of which he was named the top quizzer. Darl became a Life Master of The American Contract Bridge League in 1993.

Darl was employed as an ASA Assistant Actuary for Nationwide Insurance Company in Columbus, Ohio since December 1986.

Darl was killed in an automobile accident on March 30, 1996 in Columbus, Ohio.
