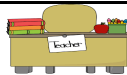

We will be utilizing "Talking Chips" discussions to have conversations around the BIG Question in Reading/Language Arts. You can organize a "Talking Chips" discussion to resolve decision-making issues or promote democratic values at home in your family. First, pass out 2 chips to each participant (you can use any small token that can serve as a "chip"). When someone wants to share their idea on the topic, they may put 1 chip to the center and speak. Other team members must listen. Once a team member has exhausted their "talking chips", they have to wait and listen to all other ideas. Once all team members have shared 2 ideas and spent 2 chips, then chips can either be redistributed for another round of sharing, or the discussion can be finished. Everyone's ideas get heard as participants practice listening skills!
