Full STEAM Ahead

We just wrapped up an Amusement Park Map team project, which took us around two weeks to complete. We talked as a class about the different elements of **STEAM** and how we worked them into the project by using protractors to measure our map scale (**Math**), using construction paper to create dimension on our map (**Art**), drafting a plan to get started AND sticking to it, (**Engineering**), and selecting Clipart images to include on map keys and maps (**Technology**).
