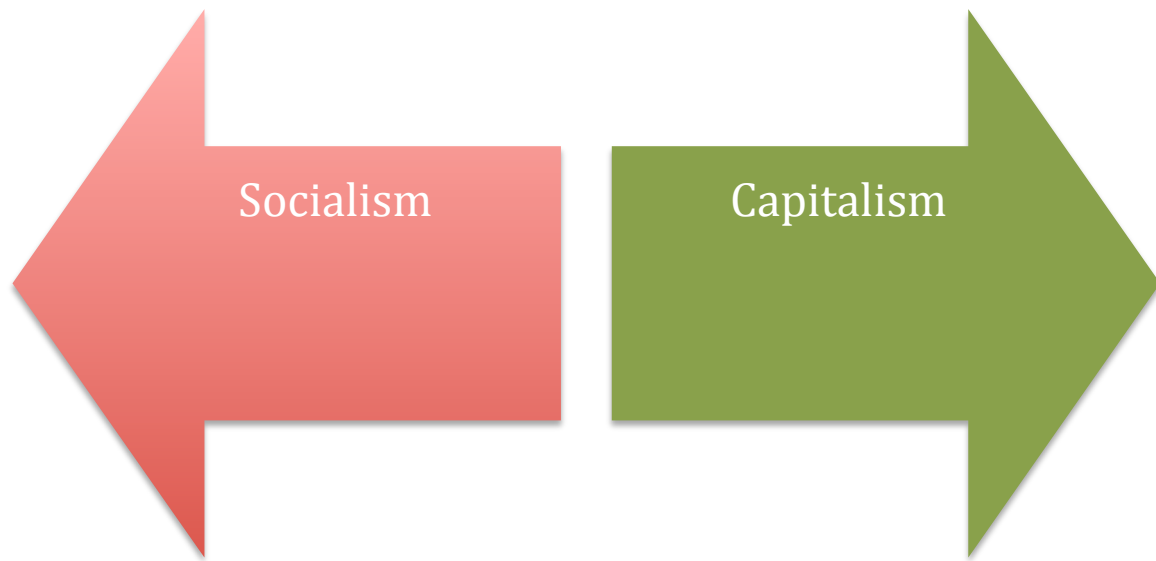
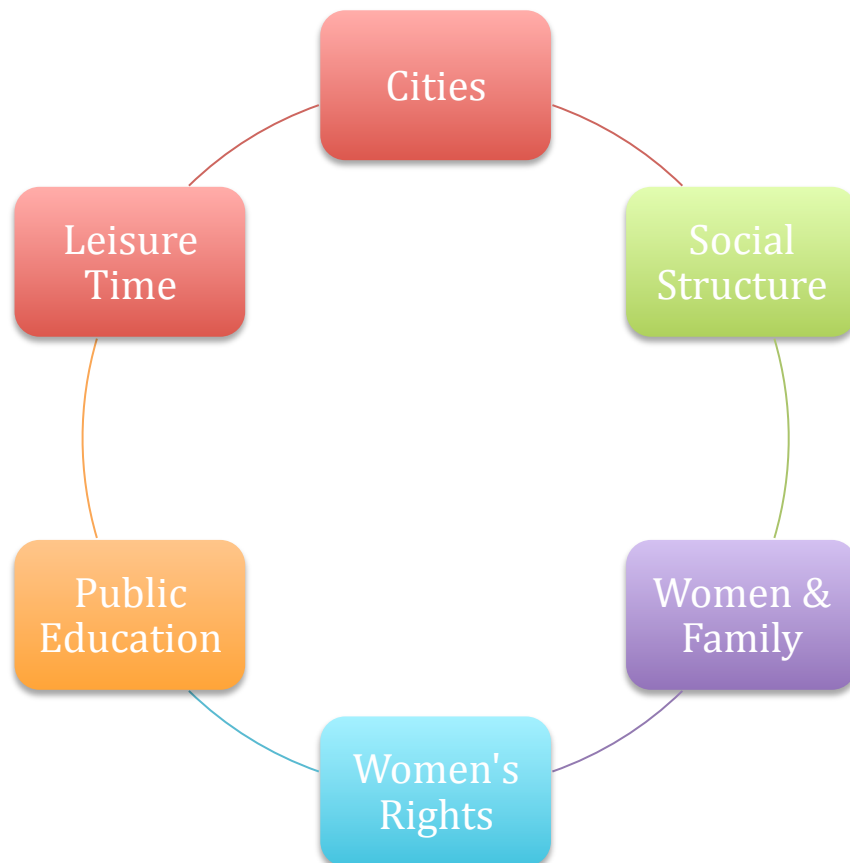


Why would people support the ideas of capitalism or socialism at the turn of the 20th century?

MAIN IDEA		EXAMPLE
Art	Use of symbols, color, light, mood, and shapes to express ideas, not reality.	
Architecture	Buildings should be functional, not fancy & ornamental.	
Music	Symbolic sound & bold rhythms are more important than melody.	
Marie Curie	Atoms are not simply hard bodies of matter, but were small active worlds.	
Albert Einstein	Time and space are relative to the observer. Matter & energy are connected, not two different things.	
Sigmund Freud	People have an subconscious they are not aware of that affects their behavior.	
Social Darwinism	People and nations are in a struggle to survive; only the best deserve to survive and reproduce.
