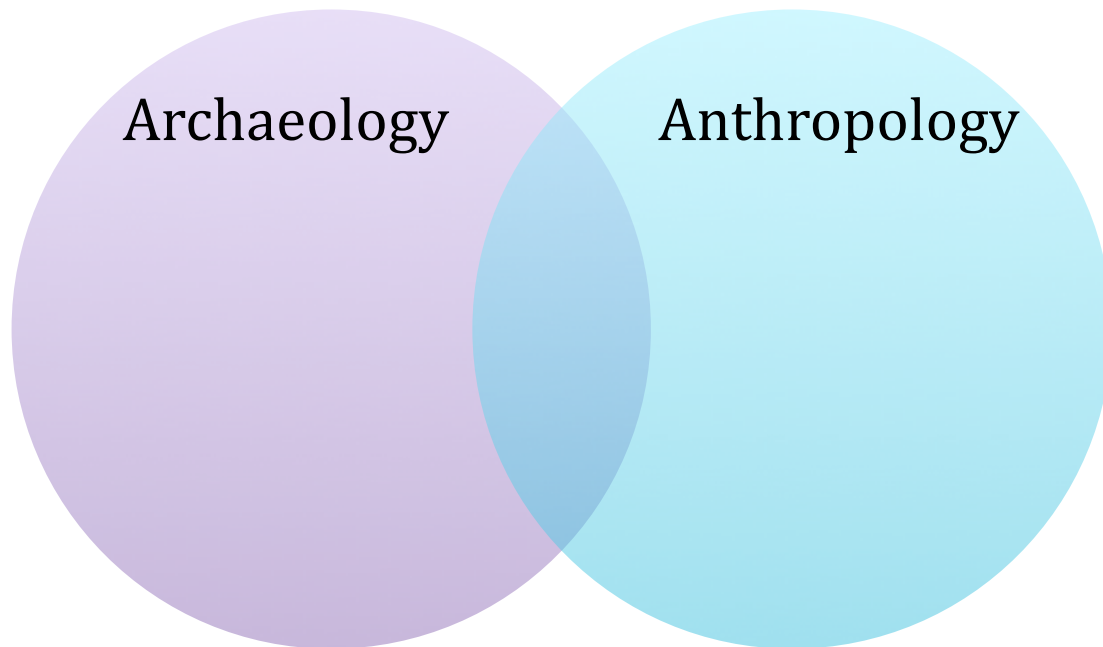
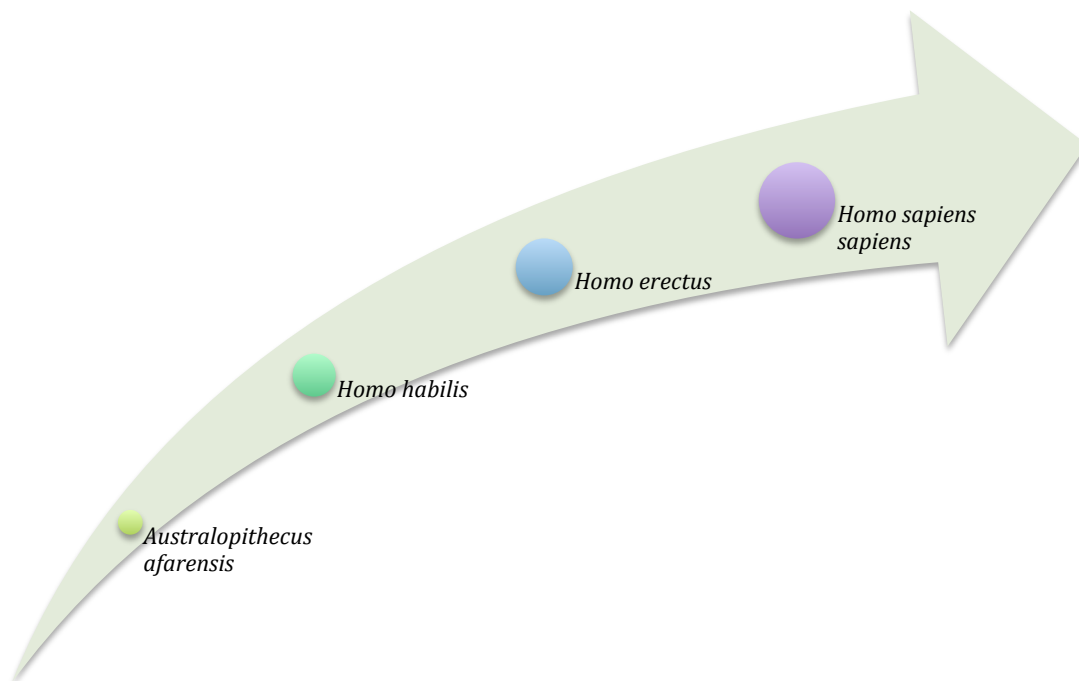

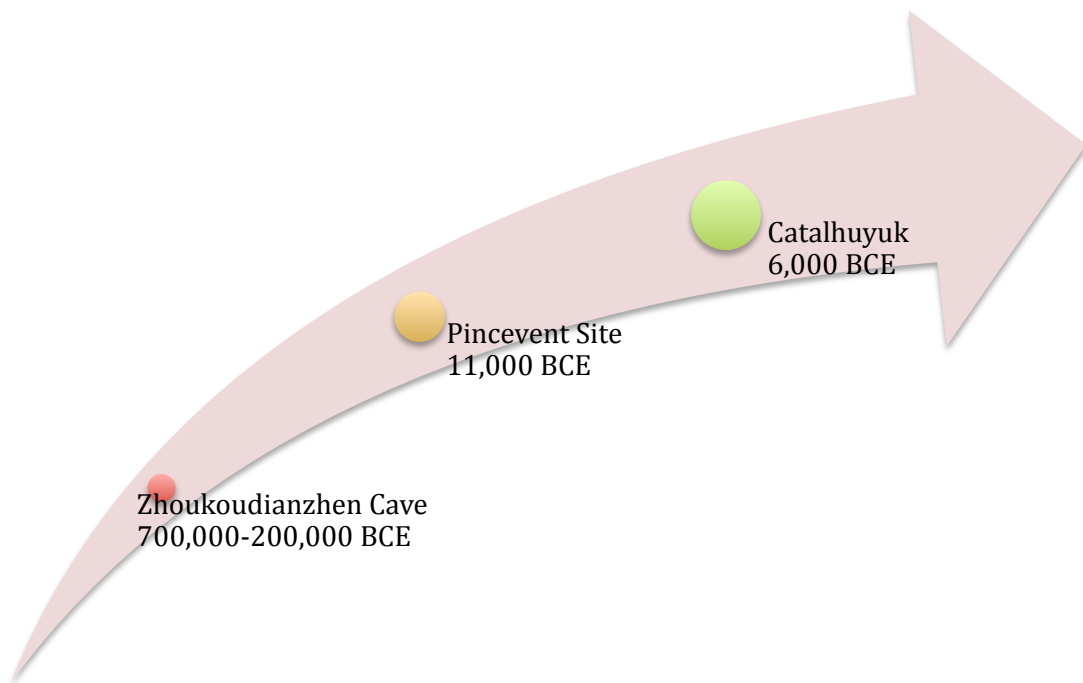
Record what we know about humans from the earliest hominids to *Homo sapiens sapiens*. What could they do? When were they around?

Describe how settlements changed over time.

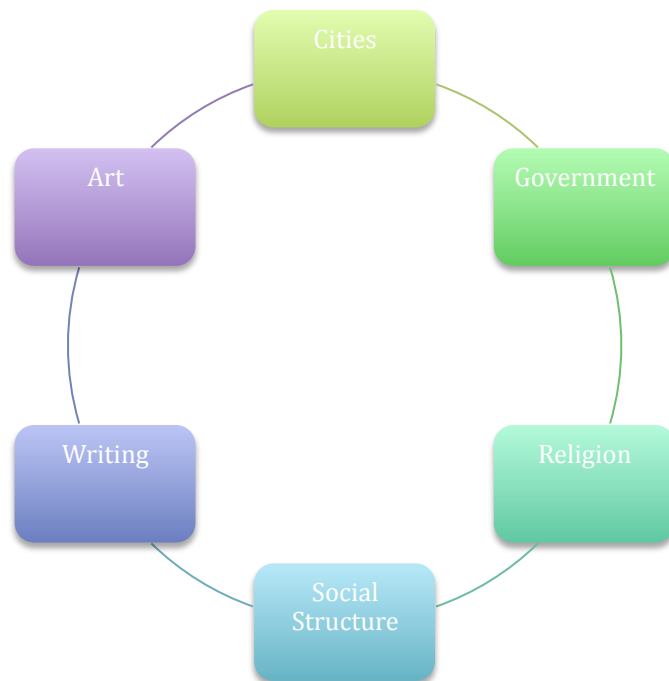
