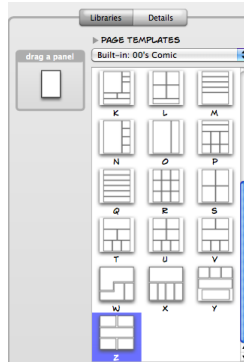


## Comic Life

1. To open Comic Life click on the Comic Life icon in your dock.



2. Choose a template and drag it to your page.



3. Click on one of the panels in the template. Select all the panels – Apple A. Lock the template – Apple L

4. To add a picture, drag it from the iPhoto Library, Finder or Capture option on the right. Click on the image to get the green handles, this allows you to resize.



5. You can also drag in Lettering, a text box and comic bubbles into your template.



6. To change the size, style & color of your font click on the Fonts icon.



## Comic Life Tips

1. Grab the blue dot to move the tail to a new location.



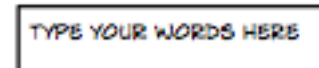
2. You can create a title with lettering. Click on the blue dots to stretch out your lettering.



Select the Style icon to change the color and style of the lettering.



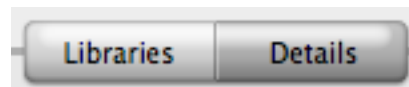
3. You can add text with a text box.



4. If your panel is outlined in orange, you will not be able to edit. Click off of the panel and then click back in.

5. To add a second image into your panel, hold down the Apple key, grab your image and drag into the panel.

6. Click on a panel and select Details. This lets you add color to the background, change the shape, and add shadows to the page and panels.



7. Click on an image and select Details to adjust the image.
