

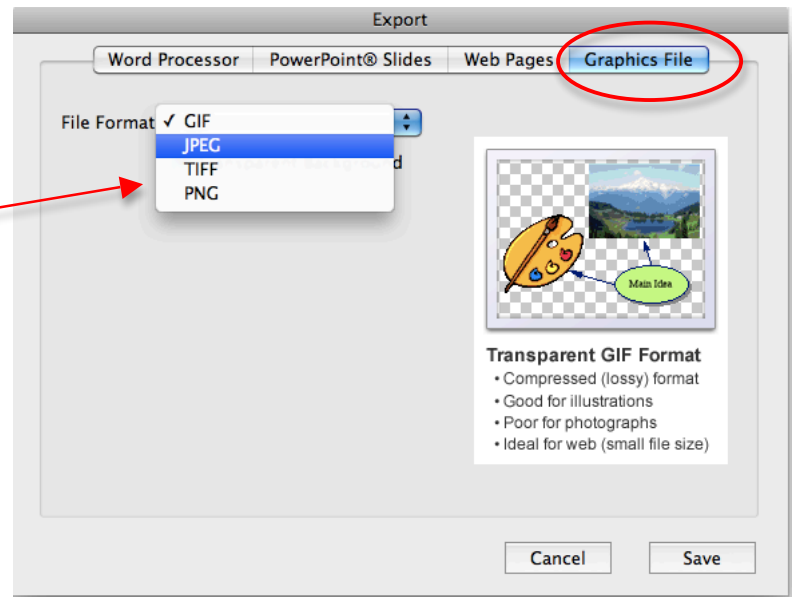
## Exporting Your Inspiration

1. Open your Inspiration document. Go up to **File** and select **Export**.

2. In the next window click on the **Graphic File** tab.

Click on the drop down menu next to **File Format** and select **JPG**.

Click **Save**.



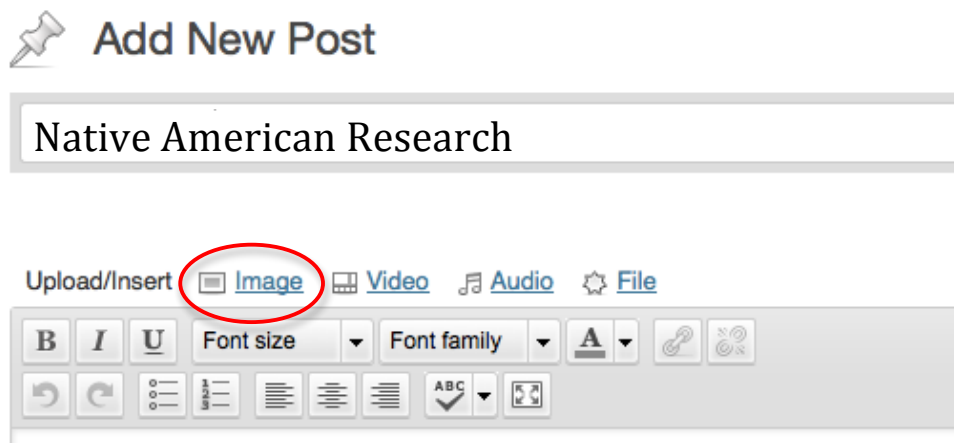
3. Make sure your document is titled and save to your **Desktop**.

## Posting your Inspiration File to Kidblog

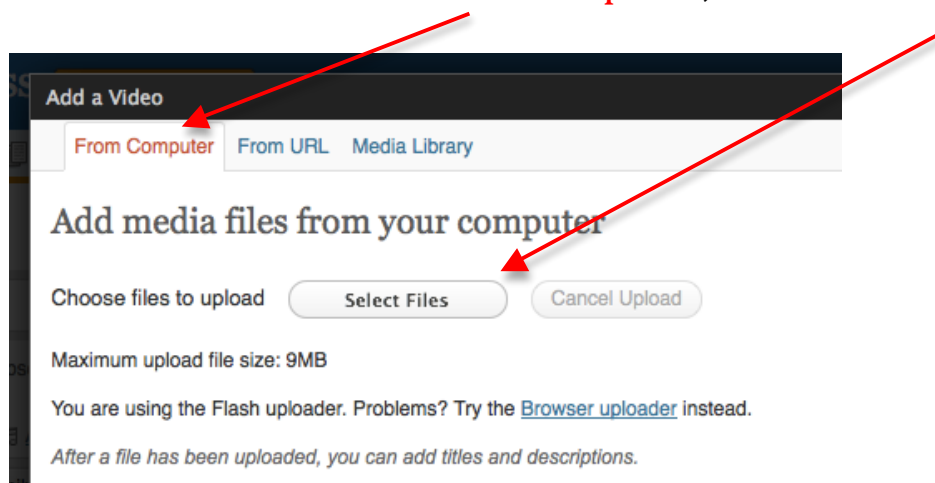
1. Log into your Kidblog, go to your blog and select New Post.



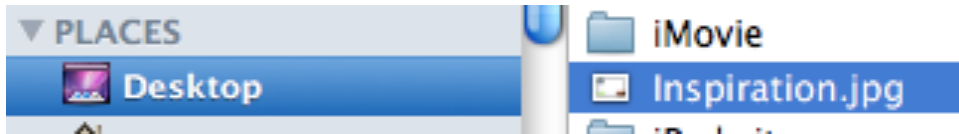
2. Title your Post, then select Image.



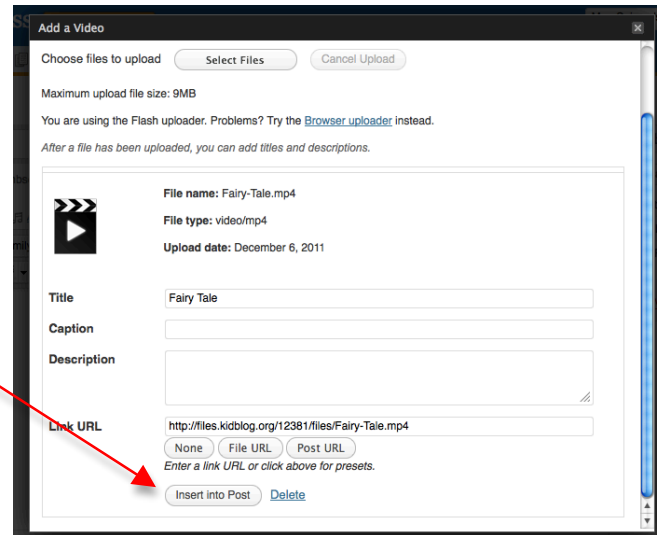
3. In the next window select **From Computer**, then Select Files.



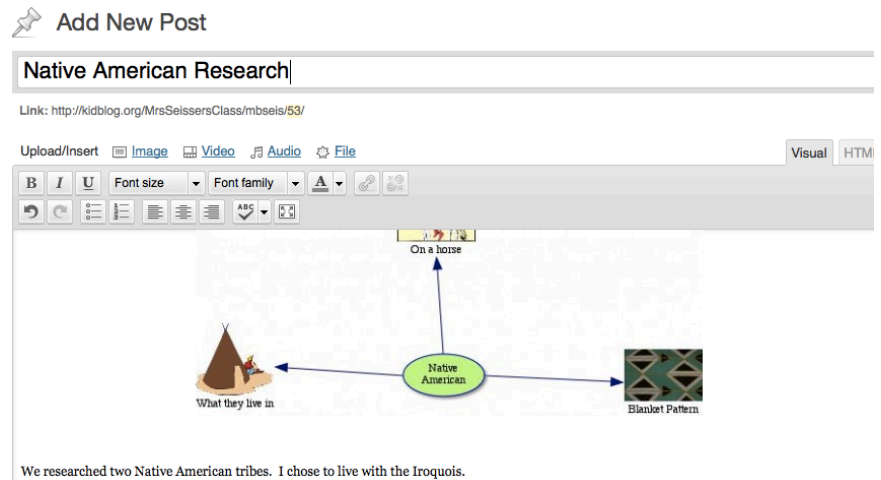
4. Click on **Desktop** on the left, then navigate to your Inspiration file. It will end in .jpg



5. Scroll down to the bottom of the next window and click on **Insert into Post**.



6. Return once and type a description:  
For Example:  
**We researched two Native American tribes. I chose to live with the Iroquois.**



7. Have your post checked and then select Publish.
