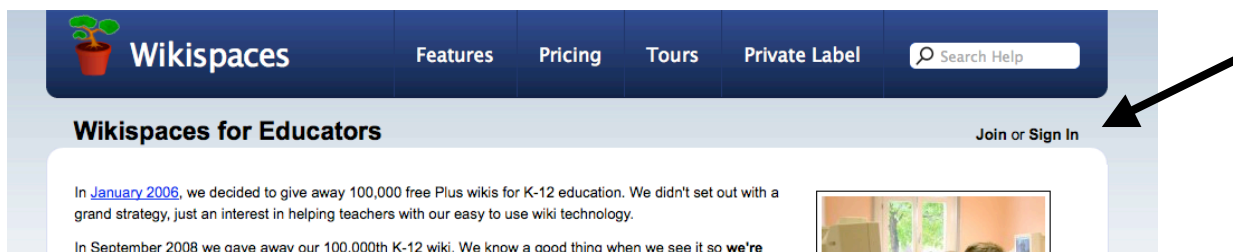


How to Create a Classroom Wiki

Now that you have joined the Westgate Wiki you have created an account and you can easily create a classroom wiki.

1. Sign onto <http://www.wikispaces.com/site/for/teachers>
If you have already joined the Westgate wiki click **Sign In**



2. Type in the Username and Password you used to join the Westgate Wiki.
