

Keynote to QuickTime Movie

1. If you have multiple Keynotes that you want to make into one movie you will need to put them all in one Keynote file.

a. Open a Keynote and create a Title page

b. Open each Keynote and drag all slides into the Title page Keynote

c. When all the Keynotes are in one, Save.

2. Now you can add all your transitions and timing. Open the Inspector

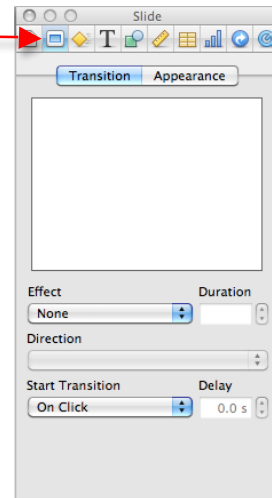


3. Click on the Slide tab.

a. Effect – you can choose a different transition or effect between your slides. Click on the drop down menu under Effect. Choose the transition/effect you want. You will see the effect preview in the window. Next choose how long you want your transition/effect. If you want the same transition/effect on all the slides, select all the slides and choose your transition/effect.

b. If your transition/effect has a direction you can choose which way you want it to go under the drop down menu under Direction.

c. Click on the drop down menu under Start Transition and choose Automatically and choose how long you want the slide(s) to appear on the screen.

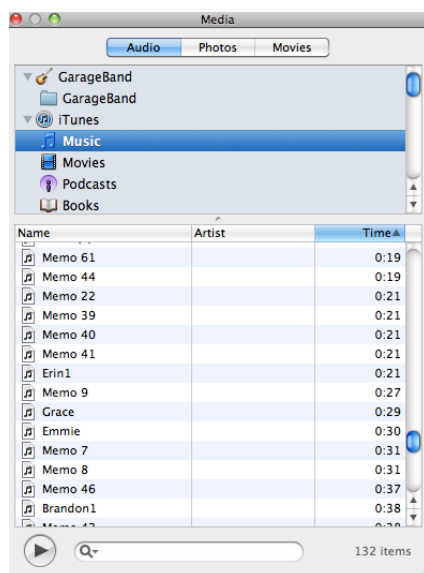
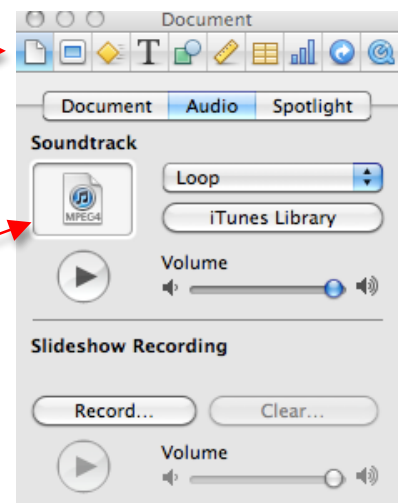


4. If you want to add Music, select the Document tab.

a. You will need to have the music in your iTunes library or in an audio file. You can create music in GarageBand and export it to iTunes.

b. Click on the Media tab if your music is in iTunes.

c. Find your song in iTunes or on your desktop and drag it to the Soundtrack window. Choose Loop in the drop down menu so the song plays throughout the movie.



5. Play your Keynote to preview and then Save. In your saved Keynote, go up to Share and choose Export.



6. Select the QuickTime tab. Click on the drop down menu next to Playback Uses. Choose Fixed Timing.

7. Set your Slide Duration to the length of time you want your slides to appear in your video. It should be the same time that you chose for your Slide transition/effect duration.

8. Select Next, then navigate to where you want your file saved. Click Export.

9. Your Keynote will now open as a QuickTime movie that you can share with students or add to your Website.
