

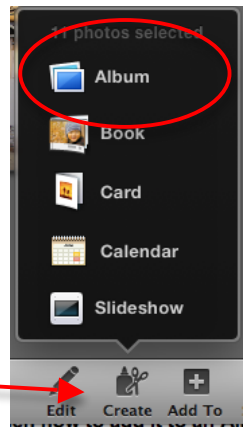

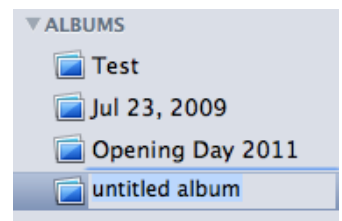
Creating an iPhoto Album to share with iWeb

1. Import your photos into iPhoto. Open the Event with the photos that you want in an album.

2. Click on **Create** in the bottom left. Choose Album.



3. In your iPhoto sidebar under Albums an Untitled Album will appear. Title your Album.



4. If you have selected and opened an Event your photos will automatically go into your album. If you want additional photos in that album, navigate to the photos and drag them to the album icon. Click on the album to make sure all your photos are there.

iWeb

1. Open iWeb and add an Album Page. Put a title on your page and in your Navigation bar. Change the placeholder text.

2. Click on the **Show Media** icon,  on the bottom right.

3. Click on the Photos Tab and scroll down until you see your album.


4. Drag your album to the album placemaker.

5. A photo page will open, title the page and change the text in placemaker text boxes.



Click on a photo to change the number of columns, spacing between photos, photos per page, and number of lines in the caption. You can also click on Album style and choose a new style.



6. Click  **Back to Index** to edit the album page. Click on the Album to see options for columns, spacing, animation, etc.

7. Drag another iPhoto album on this page to add more albums.

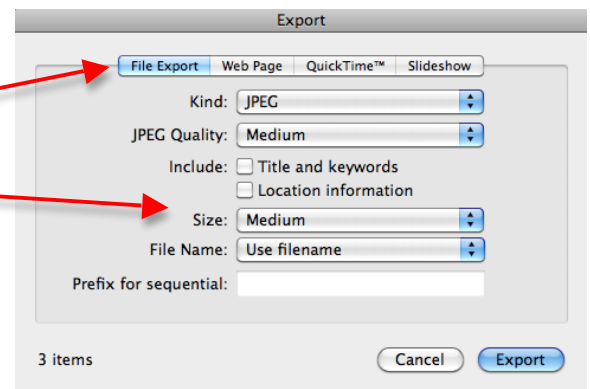
Retrieving photos from another iPhoto

If you have students downloading pictures onto another computer other than the computer where your iWeb is accessed, you will need to transfer those photos.

1. Open iPhoto, select the photos you want to transfer.

2. Go **File** to **Export**. Select File Export at the top, change the size to Medium.

3. In the next window choose where you want to save your photos and click **OK**.



4. Transfer the photos with a jetflash or log into your user on the computer and put them in your Drop Box.

5. At your computer drag the photos into iPhoto and create your album(s).
