Quick User Tips

- When uploading images, use SHIFT to select a range of images
- Use CTRL to select individual images

Student Accounts:


Once you create an educator account, you are given a code that allows you to create up to 50 student accounts that are linked to an email address you provide. Animoto recommends using a gmail account so you can add a unique identifier (a number) to each account. For example, you can create a gmail address of:

grade4animoto@gmail.com

and assign individual student accounts as:

grade4animoto+1@gmail.com,
grade4animoto+2@gmail.com

Each account is private but when students create a new Animoto, in school or at home, an email is sent to the email address you provided during account creation, allowing you to view each video your students create even if they change their
