

## TECHNOLOGY PAIRING TRANSCRIPT

Thank for watching the testimonials. What did you glean from the students? Was there anything that caught your attention, if so, please share (time will given to share). After sharing, the participants will be instructed as follows:

Now we will begin the tech paring activity. You have a tech pairing sheet in your packets. Flip through and find it. If you would like to use a loose tech pairing sheet, to preserve your booklets, you may get one from the resource table at the front of the room. By the way, all activities in your packets have a loose sheet to them on the resource table. I know how we are, as educators, when we attend workshops. We like to preserve our packets for later use for colleagues or ideas for workshops that we may conduct. So, I was mindful of that for this workshop.

At this time, look over your tech pairing sheet, think of some technologies that might be good for each activity and record them in the appropriate places. You may use any resource available to you to help you choose, except each other at this time. We will pool ideas later when we begin lesson plan construction. Everyone has a laptop; so, use the Internet for interactive websites or tutorials. Just make sure you record the name of the site and the URL so that others can easily access for their tech toolbox later. Afterward, I will ask for a volunteer to share results of their activity.
