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## **QUESTIONS PRESENTED**

Whether Umpire Pope Sunman can unilaterally declare the Bonecourse Trial canonical; whether The Commissioner is qualified to supervise major reality altering events such as The Wyatt Masoning; whether, through negligence or malice, Umpire Pope Sunman has allowed such destructive historial events to occur without consideration of the task of the Blaseball Wiki; and whether the actions of The Commissioner and Umpire Pope Sunman, through their negligence and malice, created a situation where they were unfit to perform the duties they were bound to by The Book of Blaseball.

## **STATEMENT OF INTEREST OF AMICUS CURIAE**

The Blaseball Wiki is a not-for-profit volunteer effort recognized by fans of Blaseball all over the Material and Immaterial Planes and has been actively recording the events of Blaseball since it returned.<sup>1</sup>

The Blaseball Wiki is founded on a passion for the splort and a desire to record its history. The Blaseball Wiki has a reputation for excellence, accuracy, and an exhaustive historical record.

## **STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

Internet League Blaseball presents a unique challenge for professional historians, what with the rapid incineration and replacement of Blaseball players, the alarming feedback that forces players to switch teams in the middle of active games, and the frequent appearances of malicious legume gods. And yet, the Blaseball Wiki has risen to meet the demand of the fans for a reliable historical record.

## **ARGUMENT**
