Unless otherwise noted the following business locations will accept all types of household batteries **excluding** auto batteries.

Batteries contain toxic metals or corrosive material and therefore should not be thrown in the trash. Please refer to this list for the battery collection location nearest you.

Batteries managed through this program must be from a household source and should be dropped off at the store's camera/electronics counter (please limit drop-offs to five pounds).
