- ✓ Cephus columba (Pigeon / Gull) Common in caves about coast.
- ✓ Larus occidentalis (western / Gull) Common.
- ✓ Larus heermanni (Heermann's / Gull) A few seen.
- ✓ Arenaria interpres (Ruddy Turnstone) A few seen in March 1886.
- ✓ Haematopus melanoccephala (Black / Oystercatcher) A few seen.
- ✓ Ardea herodias (Great Blue / Heron) One seen.
- ✓ Zenaidura macroura (Mourning / Dove) Common.
- ✓ Pandion h. carolinensis (Osprey) Not common.
- ✓ Haliaeetus leucocephalus (Bald / Eagle) Common.
- ✓ Falco (o. annatum ?) (Peregrine / Falcon) Few seen.
- ✓ Colaptes cafer (Northern / Flicker) Not uncommon.

✓ Micropus melanoleucus (white-throated) Swift few seen.✓ Trochilus Alleni (Allen's Hummingbird) Common✓ Ceryle alcyon (Belted Kingfisher) Seen in March 1886✓ Sayornis nigra (Black Phoebe) Common.✓ Empidonax (western Flycatcher) Very common.✓ Apelocoma insularis (scrub Jay) Common and very tame.✓ Corvus sinuatus (common Raven) Common.✓ Sturnella neglecta (western meadowlark) A few seen.✓ Carpodacus (House Finch) Not very common✓ Passerilla (Fox Sparrow) Seen in March 1886.✓ Pipilo megalonyx (Spotted Towhee) Rather common.✓ Helminthophila (Orange-winged Warbler) Seen in March 1886.✓ Chelidon erythrogaster (Barn Swallow) Abundant.✓ Lanius l. gambeli (Loggerhead Shrike) A few seen.✓ Salpinctes obsoletus (Rock Wren) Not very common.✓ Thryothorus bairdi (Baird's Wren) Common.
