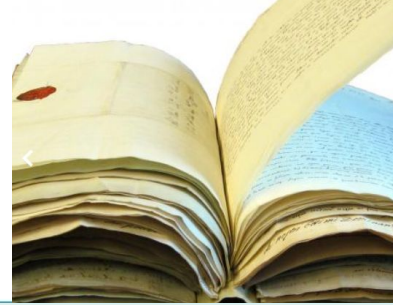

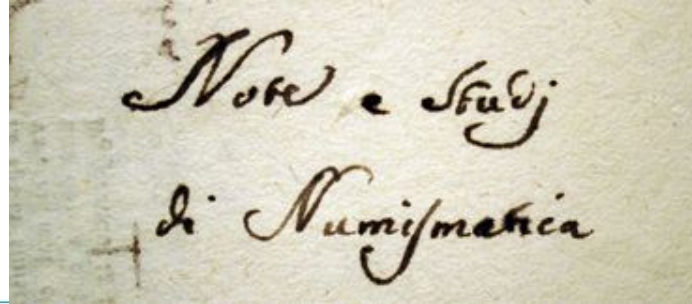
- **growing general interest in antiquarianism and historiography, of which numismatics forms an important part**

This material is scattered all over the world in archives and public as well as private libraries and is *largely unknown today*; hence, it is frequently overlooked by scholars.

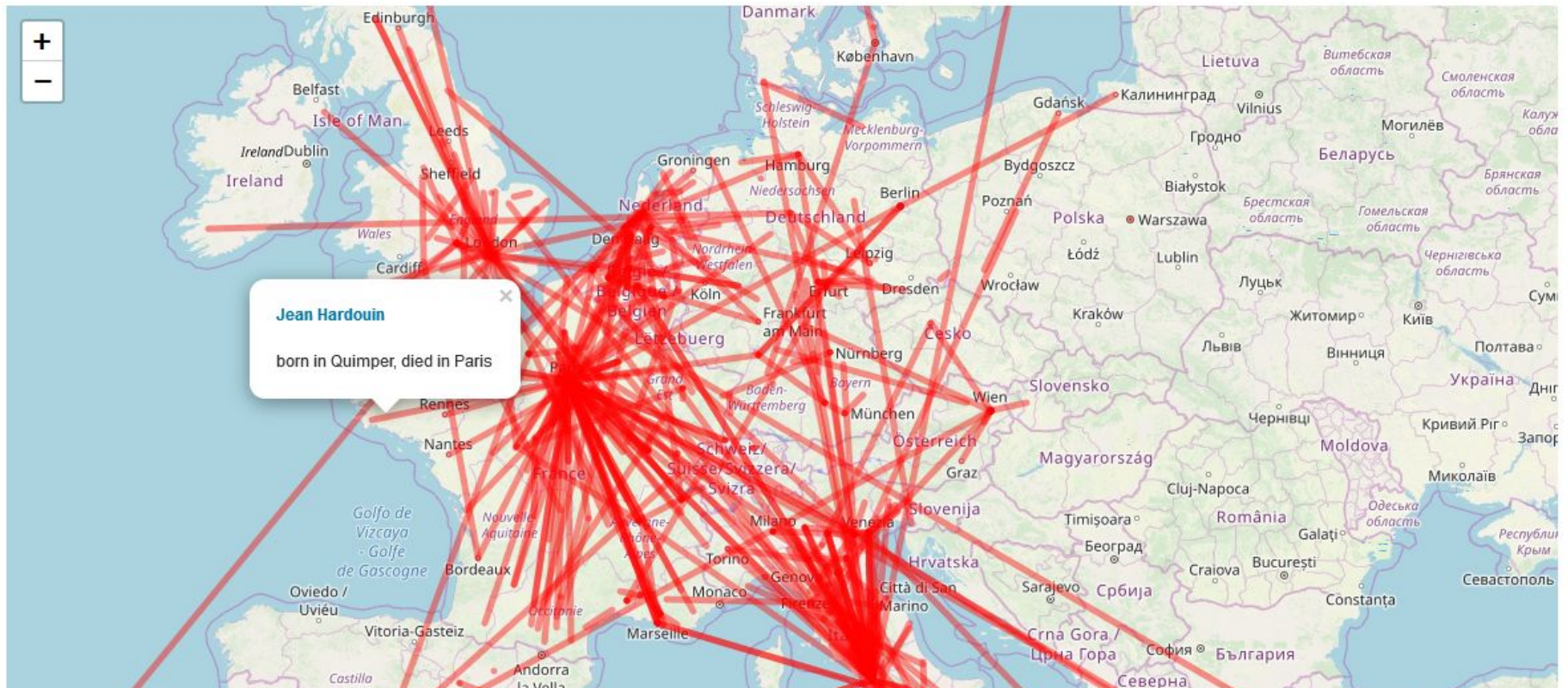
