1. WHEN:

Compost will be made available for pickup on the following days/times.

Tuesday, September 15, from 8:30 am to 12pm
 Wednesday, September 16, from 8:30 am to 12pm
 Thursday, September 17, from 8:30 am to 12pm

2. WHERE:

Southeast Wastewater Treatment Plant
 Entrance for pickup on Jerrold Avenue at Phelps Street (about 300 feet away from Phelps Street)

3. QUANTITY

Approximately one ton per community garden (conversion rate for one ton = 2.5 cubic yards which is around the volume of one pickup truck bed.) *NOTE: You can get as little as you would like. We will be able to provide you with more compost in the event there is more available/left.*
