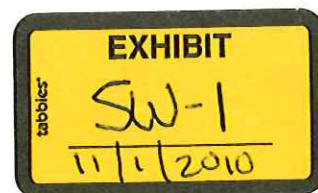

**Agreement Between
JVS Consulting, LLC and Brett Davis for Lt. Governor**

THIS AGREEMENT (hereinafter, Agreement) is made and entered into as of this 29th day of January, 2010 by and between **JVS Consulting Ventures, Inc.**, 331 W. Harrison St., Columbus, WI 53925 (hereinafter JVS Consulting) and **Brett Davis for Lt. Governor**, 1420 Raven Oaks Trail, Oregon, WI 53575.

1. JVS Consulting agrees to perform and render donor development and related consulting services and assistance to Brett Davis for Lt. Governor in connection with its overall campaign strategies for the state of Wisconsin.
2. JVS Consulting shall serve as consultant to Brett Davis for Lt. Governor for the period February 1, 2010 through March 31, 2010. As compensation for the services to be performed by JVS Consulting under this Agreement, Brett Davis for Lt. Governor agrees to pay to JVS Consulting the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000), payable as follows: One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) per month, payable on the first day of each month during the term hereof, commencing February 1, 2010 and continuing for two (2) consecutive months.
3. JVS Consulting shall prepare a monthly invoice that reflects any expenses incurred, e.g. travel, postage, telephone, etc. and includes documentation supporting such expenses.
4. Brett Davis for Lt. Governor agrees to provide all reasonable assistance to JVS Consulting in furtherance of JVS Consulting's efforts on behalf of Brett Davis for Lt. Governor. Except as contemplated by terms hereof or as required by applicable law, JVS Consulting shall keep confidential all material non-public information provided to it by Brett Davis for Lt. Governor, and shall not disclose such information to any third party, other than such of its employees and advisors as JVS Consulting determines to have a need to know. Brett Davis for Lt. Governor also acknowledges that JVS Consulting will make appropriate disclosures as required under the Wisconsin Campaign Finance laws.
5. After 2 months either party may elect to terminate this agreement at anytime with 10 days written notice. In the event of such termination no subsequent monthly payments shall be due from Brett Davis for Lt. Governor to JVS Consulting.
6. JVS Consulting agrees to perform its services under this agreement in accordance with its terms and any reasonable instructions that may from time to time be given to it by Brett Davis for Lt. Governor. JVS Consulting shall further perform its obligations hereunder in compliance with all applicable federal, state or local laws and regulations.

JVS Consulting Ventures, Inc and Brett Davis for Lt. Governor

7. JVS Consulting is engaged as an independent contractor and shall not act or be deemed to be a partner, joint venturer or agent of Brett Davis for Lt. Governor for any purpose.

8. This Agreement is not assignable by either party in any manner, by operation of law or otherwise without consent of the other party.

9. The language contained herein shall be deemed as approved by both parties hereto and no rule of strict construction shall be applied against any party hereto.

10. This Agreement is made pursuant to and shall be governed under and by the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

**Agreement Between
JVS Consulting, LLC and Brett Davis for Lt. Governor**

THIS AGREEMENT (hereinafter, Agreement) is made and entered into as of this 29th day of January, 2010 by and between JVS Consulting Ventures, Inc., 331 W. Harrison St., Columbus, WI 53925 (hereinafter JVS Consulting) and Brett Davis for Lt. Governor, 1420 Raven Oaks Trail, Oregon, WI 53575.

1. JVS Consulting agrees to perform and render donor development and related consulting services and assistance to Brett Davis for Lt. Governor in connection with its overall campaign strategies for the state of Wisconsin.
2. JVS Consulting shall serve as consultant to Brett Davis for Lt. Governor for the period July 1, 2010 through September 30, 2010. As compensation for the services to be performed by JVS Consulting under this Agreement, Brett Davis for Lt. Governor agrees to pay to JVS Consulting the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500), payable as follows: Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) per month, payable on the first day of each month during the term hereof, commencing July 1, 2010 and continuing for three (3) consecutive months.
3. JVS Consulting shall prepare a monthly invoice that reflects any expenses incurred, e.g. travel, postage, telephone, etc. and includes documentation supporting such expenses.
4. Brett Davis for Lt. Governor agrees to provide all reasonable assistance to JVS Consulting in furtherance of JVS Consulting's efforts on behalf of Brett Davis for Lt. Governor. Except as contemplated by terms hereof or as required by applicable law, JVS Consulting shall keep confidential all material non-public information provided to it by Brett Davis for Lt. Governor, and shall not disclose such information to any third party, other than such of its employees and advisors as JVS Consulting determines to have a need to know. Brett Davis for Lt. Governor also acknowledges that JVS Consulting will make appropriate disclosures as required under the Wisconsin Campaign Finance laws.
5. After 2 months either party may elect to terminate this agreement at anytime with 10 days written notice. In the event of such termination no subsequent monthly payments shall be due from Brett Davis for Lt. Governor to JVS Consulting.

RACINE - Wisconsin needs jobs. Mark Neumann isn't the only person running for governor to say that, but he's emphatic about it. That's one of the reasons he's running for governor, he said during a meeting with The Journal Times editorial board Tuesday.

Unfortunately, the state lags far behind other states in offering the kind of business climate that encourages job creation, Neumann said.

While he might not have the name recognition of his biggest Republican rival Milwaukee County Executive Scott Walker or the presumptive Democratic candidate Milwaukee Mayor Tom Barrett, Neumann said he's looking to Main Street for votes. He also hopes to tap into the momentum created by the Tea Party movement.

"We are overspending. We're destroying the future of our country. We're losing jobs again in droves," Neumann told the editorial board. "When you ask about the Tea Party, I'm one of those people except that I'm probably the next step up because I got so frustrated I actually put my business aside and ran for office."

Neumann recognizes the difficulty of jumping back into politics after more than a decade out of elected office. He served two terms as 1st District Congressman, the seat now held by U.S. Rep. Paul Ryan, R-Janesville.

Neumann hopes his message resonates throughout the state in order to get the money he needs to mount a successful campaign against Walker. The two will face off in a September primary for the Republican nomination.

In order to bring jobs to the state, Neumann said the state needs to do three things - control spending, cut taxes dramatically and improve education.

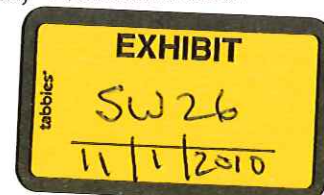
Neumann says he opposes high speed rail in Wisconsin if taxpayers have to foot the bill once it is built. He said he supports nuclear power, but isn't sure it is the answer for the future of energy. Neumann said the Republican Party in the state needs a stronger environmental platform. He wants to reduce the influence of government and would like to see the free market take its place.

Neumann, who has a company that manages choice schools in Milwaukee, said he supports injecting competition into the public school system by expanding the voucher program.

Neuman is positioning himself as an anti-establishment Republican candidate.

"I think in general, especially the people that are not actively involved in the parties are very tired of establishment politics and I think the Tea Party is a natural outcropping of that," Neumann said.

Mitchell ranks No. 10 in customer satisfaction

Milwaukee's Mitchell International Airport was ranked No. 10 out of 24 small airports in a new customer satisfaction study released Thursday by J.D. Power and Associates.

Mitchell International had an overall satisfaction score of 726, placing it just above the average score of 721 for the 24 U.S. airports. No. 1 on the list was Indianapolis International, with a score of 777, while No. 24 on the list was San Jose (Calif.) International, with a score of 645.

The rankings were included in J.D. Power's 2010 North American Airport Satisfaction Study.

The study examined six factors, assessed through 27 specific attributes, to determine overall customer satisfaction: airport accessibility; baggage claim; check-in/baggage check process; terminal facilities; security check; and food and retail services.

Overall passenger satisfaction with airports averages 690 on a 1,000-point scale in 2010, compared to 675 in 2008. However, satisfaction with airports in 2010 is considerably lower than satisfaction with hotels (756, on average) and rental cars (733, on average), according to J.D. Power.

The study is based on responses from more than 12,100 passengers who took a round-trip flight between January and December 2009. Passengers evaluated their departing and arriving airports, and the study includes a total of more than 24,200 evaluations.

Among 19 large airports, Detroit Metropolitan Wayne County ranked No. 1 with a 705 score, and Newark (N.J.) International ranked 19th with a 609 score. Of 20 medium sized airports, Kansas City International ranked at the top with a 742 score, and LaGuardia International, in New York, was ranked at the bottom with a 604 score.

Barrett to undergo hand surgery next week

Milwaukee Mayor Tom Barrett, who has had to relearn basic skills such as tying his shoes and writing, will undergo a second surgery Wednesday on his right hand, which was shattered with a tire iron when he was beaten last August.

Barrett says he now has about 50% to 60% use of the hand but does not know how much function he ultimately will regain.

"They told me it takes a long time for hands to heal," he said.

Barrett will undergo day surgery at Froedtert Hospital in an operation he said will take about 90 minutes. He said he does not think he will be put under general anesthesia.

The operation will entail re-breaking the bone in his index finger. It is hoped that will increase the strength in the hand.

Three or four months later he will undergo another operation on tendons in the hand, he said. Barrett also had surgery immediately after the Aug. 15 attack.

Barrett was beaten with a tire iron that shattered his hand and knocked out several teeth when he attempted to come to the aid of a West Allis woman who was calling for help. His alleged assailant, Anthony J. Peters, 20, has entered a plea of not guilty by reason of mental disease or defect and is awaiting trial.

Barrett said he plans to lighten his schedule for a couple days after next week's surgery. He said he does not have pain in the hand.

"It's more like the fingers are paralyzed," he said.

He has had to relearn tasks such as tying his shoes, buttoning and writing. For a while he wrote with his left hand and developed "good third grade penmanship." Now he can write with his right hand again, although he occasionally uses his left.

Shaking hands, one of the most basic skills of a politician, especially someone running for governor, has been a problem.

Barrett said his father instilled in him the importance of looking someone in the eye and using a firm handshake.

But that can be painful. So he often shakes hands with his left hand.

Barrett said he used to golf and bowl a couple of times of year, but since the incident has not tried either sport.

"You just deal with it," he said.

MCTS Release:

MCTS 2009 Ridership Review

Milwaukee, WI – The downturn in the economy greatly affected Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) Ridership in 2009 which decreased by roughly 8.7 percent. In turn, this also affected revenue that decreased by 8.95 percent from all sources.

In 2009 MCTS serviced 39,405,363 revenue passengers compared to 46,371,665 in 2008, and revenue was \$41,202,815 in 2009 compared to \$45,257,369 the previous year. A decrease was expected since the unemployment rate reached 10 percent in Milwaukee. Additional factors affecting ridership included the fare increase and service reductions; gas prices falling significantly from well over \$4 per gallon; and MPS change in purchasing fares and decrease bus use.

Use of the Freeway Flyers decreased by 13% at 610,478 in 2009 compared to 702,573 in 2008.

Last year 51,969 people with disabilities used public transit to improve their mobility. This is an increase of 7.4% percent from the previous year. This year, same as last year, Transit Plus riders were eligible for a free Freedom Pass which is a transit pass good for transportation on any MCTS bus. Cost of this pass were made possible through a Federal New Freedom Grant.

State gets positive marks for pension funds

Feb. 18, 2010 6:08 a.m. | **Madison** - Wisconsin gets positive marks for its pension fund under a new report issued by the Pew Center on the States.

The report released Thursday found that nationally there was a \$1 trillion gap between the money states and localities had put aside to pay employees' retirement benefits and how much they would actually cost.

The report finds that in 2000 slightly more than half the states had fully funded pensions but by 2006 that had shrunk to just six. By 2008, only Wisconsin, Florida, New York and Washington still had pensions that were fully funded.

Wisconsin was one of nine states designated as being a solid performer when it comes to state retiree health care and other non-pension benefits.

Talgo and Ingeteam Development Projects Move Forward

The City is close to finalizing the agreements with both Ingeteam and Talgo that will create hundreds of new manufacturing jobs for Milwaukee area workers.

This past week, both the city Redevelopment Authority and the Common Councils Zoning and Neighborhood Development Committee gave their approval to the agreements. Next week, the full Common Council will consider the files for approval.

There's been some misinformation out there this week, so I thought I'd take the opportunity to set the record straight about these two exciting economic development projects.

The Ingeteam and Talgo operations have some similarities. Both are Spanish companies; both are leaders in their respective fields; both are creating new jobs in growing industries; and both have selected Milwaukee to be the headquarters for their North American manufacturing operations.

There are differences, too. Ingeteam builds components for electric generation from wind and other renewable sources. It is buying land in the city's Menomonee Valley business park and constructing its own facility. The company plans to hire up to 275 people in the next few years.

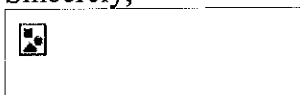
Talgo manufactures high-speed trains. It will lease a facility in a city-owned business park we call Century City. Historically, that's where A.O. Smith and Tower Automotive manufactured products including automotive frames. Talgo has contracts with both the states of Wisconsin and Oregon to produce these fast trains in Milwaukee. Along with its maintenance operations, Talgo plans to employ 125 Milwaukee workers.

There is a lot of competition among communities all across the United States to attract these types of employers. When we are working to bring jobs to Milwaukee, we need to be good negotiators and respect taxpayers. In the end, I believe government incentives are appropriate when we are creating and retaining jobs here.

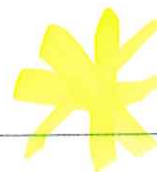
I want to thank the members of the Common Council, the people at our Department of City

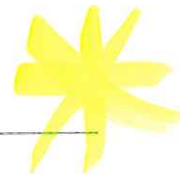

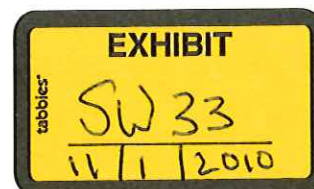

On September 24, I presented my 2010 budget to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors.

This is the eighth consecutive year that I have not increased the property tax levy from the previous year, and holding the line on taxes is the best thing that can be done to protect and create jobs in our area. Increasing taxes or imposing a wheel tax to fund county government only places an added burden on families and employers struggling to manage their own budgets. And the tax island it would create will only drive businesses and residents out of Milwaukee County.

Our administration was faced with the toughest budget outlook to date, with a projected \$78 million shortfall with rising pension and health care costs being some of the biggest drivers. It was our responsibility to prioritize, and devise creative solutions to maximize the available funds. And we did.

Public safety comes first, and we identified critical funding areas in the Sheriff's Office, District Attorney's Office and the court system. These services are essential to all other efforts we undertake to improve our economic outlook.

Our next priority entails providing services for the most needy in our community. Special needs housing and disabilities services provide help for our senior citizens, homeless, and those with developmental or physical disabilities. We balance the importance of maintaining vital human services with the need to control the growth of government spending to reflect our ability to pay.

Milwaukee County Works – the new office and accelerated building program in my budget – will provide \$395 million to the capital improvements program. This will fund more than 100 projects that will provide more than 1,000 jobs – at a time when we need jobs the most.

The Build American bonds used will save the county up to \$3 million. And the county's outstanding debt will be 28% lower in 2012 than it was in 2002.

Major budget reforms are needed and we must look at expanding the use of public-private partnerships to leverage funds for the parks, zoo and other cultural assets. Having a non-profit group (like the Zoological Society) operate the zoo with a fixed annual contribution from the county would give it long-term financial stability (many zoos like San Diego and Brookfield already do this). Pension, wage and benefit costs would not absorb those funds, allowing for a maximum amount for zoo operations. And current duplication of services would be eliminated.

My budget allocates more than \$38 million for investments and improvements in the parks system –

from new aquatic centers and splash pads to replacing bathrooms, playground equipment and resurfacing parkways. Our parks system is up for the national Gold Medal as the best in the country and we plan on keeping it the best.

The budget maintains the existing bus routes and creates a new Bus Rapid Transit line from the county grounds, through downtown Milwaukee and up to the main University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee campus. It will dramatically improve service and will be part of a new backbone to the entire transit system.

The largest factor to address a balanced budget remains employee wage and benefit costs that are substantially greater than those in the private sector. Over 48% of the county budget goes to fund this area. We are proposing that county employees contribute 5% to retirement (the national average), and 15% toward health care costs (Racine County and others do this too). County employees are paid by the public and cannot have wages and benefits so much greater than the taxpayers who pay the bills.

Overall, we put together a responsible budget that protects the taxpayer – residential and commercial – while providing vital services like public safety, quality of life, transportation and safety net programs for older adults, veterans, people suffering from mental illness and people with developmental and physical disabilities. We do it through major reforms so that we can get the people of Milwaukee County working again.

Was the county executive unaware of the actions of his cabinet member regarding this contract?
2. What role did County Executive Scott Walker have in the selection and appointment of Bill Domina as corporation counsel?

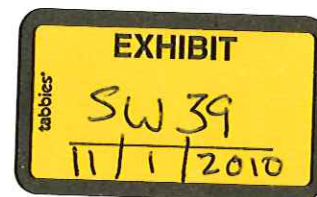

Let public see state spending, group urges candidates

Madison -- State government in Wisconsin has fallen behind most other states in giving taxpayers online information about how their money is being spent, according to a new report.

The Wisconsin Public Interest Research Group is calling on gubernatorial candidates Scott Walker and Tom Barrett to fix that if they are elected governor, director Bruce Speight said.

"Our neighbors in Minnesota and Illinois are far ahead of us," Speight said. "What happened to Wisconsin's long and proud tradition of open government?"

Nationwide, 32 states have opened their checkbooks and put detailed information on their spending online for citizens to see. Speight said that has helped at least a few states save millions of dollars on misplaced spending.

Wisconsin has placed information on some spending on state contracts on its Contract Sunshine website. The information on that site has improved in the most recent year, but

still only covers about 37 of the roughly 100 state agencies with contracts that are supposed to be included on the site, Speight said. The Contract Sunshine site also only covers contracts of \$10,000 or more.

Speight said the state should include on the site all spending from all state agencies — something he said a governor could accomplish by executive order without needing to go the state Legislature.

Check back later Monday for reaction from the gubernatorial candidates.

The letter our office edited to correct info on what Milwaukee County did is below:

In 2007, as governor of Missouri, I created the Missouri Accountability Portal to help citizens root out wasteful spending. The Portal has been tremendously successful in allowing Missourians to track their tax dollars, making our government more accessible and transparent. I have continued to speak out for greater transparency in government spending at every level - local, state, and federal. That is why I was so pleased to learn that Milwaukee County Executive Scott Walker was creating the Milwaukee County Accountability Portal (MCAP).

Just like the Missouri Accountability Portal, MCAP users can browse county expenditures by category, department, or vendor. Eventually, salaries of county employees and information regarding tax credits can be included. Users can access this information in near real-time, with information updated at the end of each business day.

The MCAP does an excellent job of taking advantage of technology to keep citizens informed on local county government. The MCAP has been lauded by pro-taxpayer groups such as Americans for Tax Reform.

To help ensure wise spending, we have to have government that is transparent and accountable to taxpayers. Public scrutiny is a vital firewall against wasteful and uncontrolled spending. Fortunately for Milwaukee County citizens, Scott Walker has decided that government in secret is not in the best interests of taxpayers.

Brad Montgomery, being first duly sworn on oath, deposes and says that:

1. I am a Special Agent with the Wisconsin Division of Criminal Investigation. I am a certified Wisconsin police officer employed as a sworn Special Agent with the Wisconsin Division of Criminal Investigation. I have been a police officer since 1994.

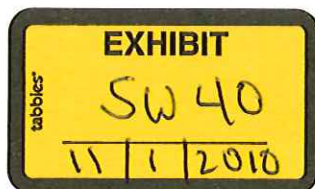
2. I have received more than 400 hours training in the investigation of computer and internet crimes, and methods of forensic analysis of computers used in criminal activity.

3. I have myself provided more than 600 hours of training related to computer and internet crime investigations, and methods of forensic analysis of computers used in criminal activity to local, state and federal law enforcement personnel, as well military personnel and individuals employed with private corporations.

4. Since 1998 I have been assigned by the Administrator of the Wisconsin Division of Criminal Investigation to investigate complaints of computer related crimes and internet crimes and to conduct forensic examinations of computers used in criminal activity.

5. Since 2003 I have been employed as a part-time instructor for a company called Guidance Software. In this capacity, I instruct local, state, and federal law enforcement employees. I also instruct military and government intelligence agency employees and the employees of foreign governments and private corporations. I instruct these persons on how to perform computer forensics and computer crime investigations, including computer network incident response.

6. I know that it is common for businesses to maintain and use computerized systems to conduct email communications for business use. In fact, I believe that the



use of computers in business, including the use of electronic messaging and especially electronic mail (commonly referred to as e-mail), is a standard practice. Certainly, the fact that the Wisconsin & Southern Railroad (WSOR) maintains a website at www.wsorrailroad.com is a strong indicator that it uses computer resources as part of its business. Further, as set forth in Exhibit F of the June 15, 2010 Nickel Affidavit, the fact that a business advertises e-mail addresses of its employees is a clear and common sense indication that the corporation is using e-mail.

COMPUTERS AND ELECTRONIC STORAGE

7. As described in the Affidavit of Dean Nickel dated June 24, 2010 which I incorporate herein by reference, this application seeks permission to search and seize records at the Wisconsin & Southern Railroad (WSOR) offices, in whatever form they are found.

8. I believe there is good cause to believe that records stored in an electronic format will be found on the premises. I am advised, by virtue of a review of the Nickel Affidavits dated June 15, 2010 and June 24, 2010, that a number of the communications between William Gardner and his former girlfriend, Stacie Long, were exchanged through electronic mail. At least one of those e-mails indicates that Gardner used an e-mail address of bgardner@wsorrailroad.com, an e-mail address attributable to a Wisconsin & Southern Railroad e-mail system. See Exhibit D to the June 15, 2010 Nickel Affidavit. I also understand that Gardner used several Google Gmail accounts, a web-based e-mail account that can be accessed anywhere where there is access the Internet, including (in all likelihood) the WSOR offices. I submit that if a computer or electronic medium is found within the WSOR offices, especially a computer workstation or electronic medium used by any of the WSOR employees named in the Nickel Affidavits, there is probable cause to believe relevant records will be stored in that computer or electronic medium, for at least the following reasons:

a. Based on my knowledge, training, and experience, I know that computer files or remnants of such files can be recovered months or even years after they have been downloaded onto a hard drive, deleted or viewed via the Internet.

Electronic files downloaded to a hard drive can be stored for years at little or no cost. Even when files have been deleted, they can be recovered months or years later using readily available forensics tools. This is so because when a person

"deletes" a file on a computer, the data contained in the file does not actually disappear; rather, that data remains on the hard drive until it is overwritten by new data.

b. Therefore, deleted files, or remnants of deleted files, may reside in free space or slack space - that is, in space on the hard drive that is not currently being used by an active file - for long periods of time before they are overwritten. In addition, a computer's operating system may also keep a record of deleted data in a "swap" or "recovery" file.

c. Similarly, files that have been viewed via the Internet are typically automatically downloaded into a temporary Internet directory or "cache." The browser often maintains a fixed amount of hard drive space devoted to these files, and the files are only overwritten as they are replaced with more recently viewed Internet pages or if a user takes steps to delete them.

9. Based upon my knowledge, training and experience, I know that searching for information stored in computers often requires agents to seize most or all electronic storage devices to be searched later by a qualified computer expert in a laboratory or other controlled environment. This is often necessary to ensure the accuracy and completeness of such data, and to prevent the loss of the data either from accidental or intentional destruction. Additionally, to properly examine those storage devices in a laboratory setting, it is often necessary that some computer equipment, peripherals, instructions, and software be seized and examined in the laboratory setting. This is true because of the following:

a. The volume of evidence. Computer storage devices (like hard disks or CD-ROMs) can store the equivalent of millions of pages of information. Additionally, a suspect may try to conceal criminal evidence; he or she might store it in random order with deceptive file names. This may require searching authorities to peruse all the stored data to determine which particular files are evidence or instrumentalities of crime. This sorting process can take weeks or months, depending on the volume of data stored, and it would be impractical and invasive to attempt this kind of data search on-site.

b. Technical requirements. Searching computer systems for criminal evidence sometimes requires highly technical processes requiring expert skill and properly

controlled environment. The vast array of computer hardware and software available requires even computer experts to specialize in some systems and applications, so it is difficult to know before a search which expert is qualified to analyze the system and its data. In any event, however, data search protocols are exacting scientific procedures designed to protect the integrity of the evidence and to recover even "hidden," erased, compressed, password-protected, or encrypted files. Because computer evidence is vulnerable to inadvertent or intentional modification or destruction (both from external sources or from destructive code imbedded in the system as a "booby trap"), a controlled environment may be necessary to complete an accurate analysis.

10. In light of these concerns, subject to ¶11 below, I hereby request the Court's permission to seize the computer hardware (and associated peripherals) that are believed to contain some or all of the evidence described in the warrant, and to conduct an off-site search of the hardware for the evidence described, if, upon arriving at the scene, the agents executing the search conclude that it would be impractical to search the computer hardware on-site for this evidence.

11. With respect to the search of WSOR, I recognize that WSOR is a functioning company with many employees, and that a seizure of the company's computers may have the unintended effect of limiting the company's ability to provide service to its legitimate customers. In response to these concerns, the agents who execute the search anticipate taking an incremental approach to minimize the inconvenience to the Company's legitimate customers and to minimize the need to seize equipment and data. It is anticipated that, barring unexpected circumstances, this incremental approach will proceed as follows:

- a. Upon arriving at WSOR, the agents will attempt to identify a system administrator of the network (or other knowledgeable employee) who will be willing to assist law enforcement by identifying, copying, and printing out paper and electronic copies of the things described in the warrant. The assistance of such an employee might allow agents to place less of a burden on the Company than would otherwise be necessary. If the employees choose not to assist the agents, the agents decide that none are trustworthy, or for some other reason the agents cannot execute the warrant successfully without themselves

examining the company's computers, the agents will attempt to locate the things described in the warrant, and will attempt to make electronic copies of those things. This analysis will focus on things that may contain the evidence and information of the violations under investigation. In doing this, the agents might be able to copy only those things that are evidence of the offenses described herein, and provide only those things to the case agent. Circumstances might also require the agents to attempt to create an electronic "image" of those parts of the computer that are likely to store the things described in the warrant. Generally speaking, imaging is the taking of a complete electronic picture of the computer's data, including all hidden sectors and deleted files. Imaging a computer permits the agents to obtain an exact copy of the computer's stored data without actually seizing the computer hardware. The agents or qualified computer experts will then conduct an off-site search for the things described in the warrant from the "mirror image" copy at a later date. If the agents successfully image the company's computers, the agents will not conduct any additional search or seizure of the company's computers.

b. If imaging proves impractical, or even impossible for technical reasons, then the agents will seize those components of the company's computer system that the agents believe must be seized to permit the agents to locate the things described in the warrant at an off-site location. The seized components will be removed from the premises. If employees of the company so request, the agents will, to the extent practicable, attempt to provide the employees with copies of data that may be necessary or important to the continuing function of the company's legitimate business. If, after inspecting the computers, it is determined that some or all of this equipment is no longer necessary to retrieve and preserve the evidence, the government will return it within a reasonable time.

Backup Tapes

12. Based on my training and experience, I know that it is a customary business practice to create backup copies of computer generated data. Such data may take the form of word processing files, spreadsheets files, database files of all kinds and electronic messaging information, including e-mail information.

13. User data, *i.e.*, the data files created by the computer users, is frequently backed up to a tape drive by a network technician or administrator. The resulting backup tape is itself a form of information in electronic form. Using special back-up drives and special backup software, a second set of user data is created to insure against a calamitous loss of data due to equipment malfunction, casualty loss, file corruption or some other unplanned event.

14. Data Backup is customarily performed by businesses on a daily basis. There are different types of data backups. Full Data backups make a complete copy of user data. Such full data backups are usually done on a monthly basis. Between monthly Full Backups, data is backed up on selective, interim basis that focuses on files that have been created, modified or deleted since the last Full Backup. These interim backups usually occur every day, usually at night. There are many different types of these interim backups, but they all attempt to backup only a small amount of data relative to the full backup. Restoring a whole system to a certain point in time requires using the last Full Backup together with the interim backups that cover the period of time between the Full Backup and the particular point in time to which the system is supposed to be restored.

15. Back-up data, once seized, allows the forensic investigator – if necessary – to search for files that may have been deleted from the system without any residual trace. For example, if a file named "XYZ.doc" is created and stored by a user from Day 1 to Day 10, but then is successfully and actually deleted from the system,¹ that file "XYZ.doc" can be recovered on Day 25 from a backup tape created during the period of Day 1 to Day 10.

16. In order to successfully restore such user data, the forensic investigator requires a copy of the software used to create the backup tape. This software must run on a computer using an operating system compatible with the backup software. Further, a tape drive compatible with the seized backup tape is required.



17. Based upon my training and experience, I know that most businesses will operate a networked computer system whereby individual computers (usually referred



to as workstations) are connected to central computer (usually called a file server). User data can exist on both the workstation and the file server. In many business, e-mail is managed on a central file server using software such as Microsoft's Exchange or Lotus' Notes software. In such circumstances, evidence is potentially discoverable on both the workstations and the servers.

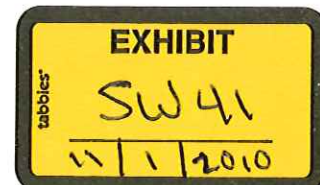

Ever wonder who has the time and motivation to go online and post all those highly partisan comments about **Journal Sentinel** stories?

Here's one:

Darlene Wink, constituent services coordinator for County Executive **Scott Walker**.

Using a pseudonym, Wink has posted about 70 comments on Journal Sentinel blogs and stories since October - most of them praising her boss, touting his gubernatorial bid or ripping his two opponents, Democratic Mayor **Tom Barrett** and ex-U.S. Rep. **Mark Neumann**, a Republican. And she was becoming increasingly prolific, offering nearly 25 comments in April, according to a routine check of online search engines.

But here's the kicker:

The vast majority of these were done while she was on the clock for the taxpayers and the county.

That's certainly not the kind of message a self-described penny-pincher like Walker wants to be sending to voters.

Just hours after being interviewed by **No Quarter** on Thursday, Wink - vice chairwoman of the Milwaukee County Republican Party - abruptly resigned her job in Walker's office. On the county payroll since 2002, the year Walker was elected county executive, Wink was paid nearly \$40,000 a year in 2008, the most recent year for which data was available.

"No one in our office had any knowledge that Darlene was posting any comments during work hours," said Walker spokeswoman **Fran McLaughlin**. "The county executive and chief of staff (**Tom Nardelli**) expressly forbid staff participation in any campaign-related activity while on county time."

There is little doubt that what Wink was writing was, in fact, related to the campaign.

Just last month, the low-profile county worker whacked both of Walker's gubernatorial foes in a comment on a story about the failed global warming bill.

"Conservatives need to listen to what Neumann is really saying - the true conservative in the race for Governor is Walker," she wrote. "I agree where was Barrett on this or any other issue during this legislative session."

She posted that at 8:44 a.m., April 23, a Friday.

Wink was at it again in a local news story on the county's layoff plans:

"I give Walker and his staff the foresight of looking ahead to resolve these issues," the Walker staffer wrote. "Let's ask why stories like this are not being done about Tom Barrett?"

That one went up at 4:16 p.m. on April 16, another Friday.

A story on Neumann's second campaign ad drew this response from Wink:

"Unless Neumann can convince the base of his own party to support him - he might as well

take his money and give it to the Walker campaign - instead of wasting it on this race - there is little or no support for him within the party."

Reached Thursday afternoon, Wink was surprisingly candid. No Quarter contacted her after receiving a tip regarding her online activity.

First, she acknowledged that she was the individual posting comments under the moniker "RPMCVP" - a reference to her position with the county party. She uses the same initials in her e-mail address listed on the county Republican Party Web site.

She also agreed that nearly all of her online comments could be described as political. She even conceded that she was going online and defending her boss on the Journal Sentinel Web site while at her county job. Asked if that was a good idea, she said, "Probably not, no."

"I never gave it a thought that it was going to be an issue," Wink said.

She did say that she brings a personal laptop to work and that she posts most - and perhaps all - of her comments using it, not a county computer. In addition, she said she tries to put in extra time doing her real job, helping fix problems raised by individual county residents, when she takes time out to read and reply to stories about Walker or other gubernatorial candidates.

But Wink said this wouldn't be reflected on her time cards.

"I get paid for eight hours (a day)," she said. "That's what they show. It doesn't show anything other than that."

No Quarter asked Walker's office for Wink's payroll records on Thursday to determine whether she was doing political work on county time.

Wink, 59, announced her resignation two hours later.

Now she can post as many comments as she wants at any time of day - without costing taxpayers a dime.

It is not possible - at least legally - to access all of Neumann's Facebook contacts. As you may know, to message all group/page members requires a group/page administrator to do so through Facebook - so, it's not even feasible to export a database of all one's fans/members. So, unfortunately, the only way to reach out to Neumann's Facebook fans is to either solicit each on individually OR buy a targeted Facebook ad that could appear on the right hand side of the page for those in a precise demographic which we could try and match to those who are fans of Neumann's page.

Also, Neumann has an astoundingly large number of fans, rather impressive if they accumulated them legitimately. I noticed that Scott has a fan page, a group, and a student group. My personal recommendation would have been to make one group for all three of these purposes, thus consolidating membership and communication, as well as making it less confusing for those seeking to become a fan of (or now "Like") Scott.

I read the blog post on the use of Openinviter as well. I do think it leaves the use of the software open for interpretation, which is good, although they probably are using the software legitimately. But, again, there's no way to tell if they are appropriating email addresses or not since its open source software, it's certainly possible for them to copy addresses to a database when users select to send them invitations - even though MyScottSpot has similar capability.

Definitely let me know if you have any more questions or ideas, I'd be more than willing to assist.

He told me an I-Phone is a miniaturized computer system consisting of a storage drive, memory and a operating system that just has a cellular chip allowing it to be used as a phone. It has the capability to store sent and received e-mails, documents either created or saved on the phone, photos and videos taken with the phone or sent to and saved on the phone as well as browser history of the phone, sent and received phone calls, text messages and chats may also be present.

He told me that what can be done is the phones drive can be cloned and then processed with en-case and pretty much everything you get by doing it with a computer drive will be pulled out of the phones drive.
