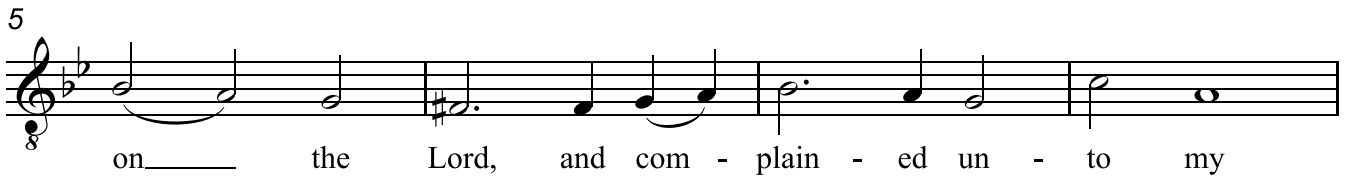


An ANTHEM taken out of the 18th Psalm

on the 4th of June, being the Day that Town was destroyed by Fire.

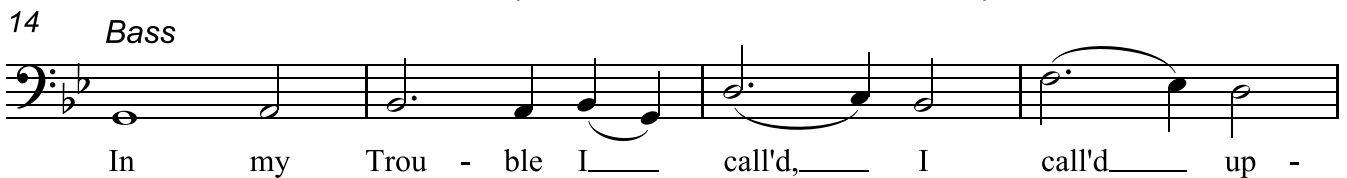
