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

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Emendations: The order of staves in the source is the same as in this edition: no indication is given of the allocation of the treble and tenor parts. The alto part is notated in the source in the treble clef an octave above sounding pitch.

The only indication of the text given in the source is the title 'Psalm ye 145th N.V.': four verses of this text have been underlaid editorially.
