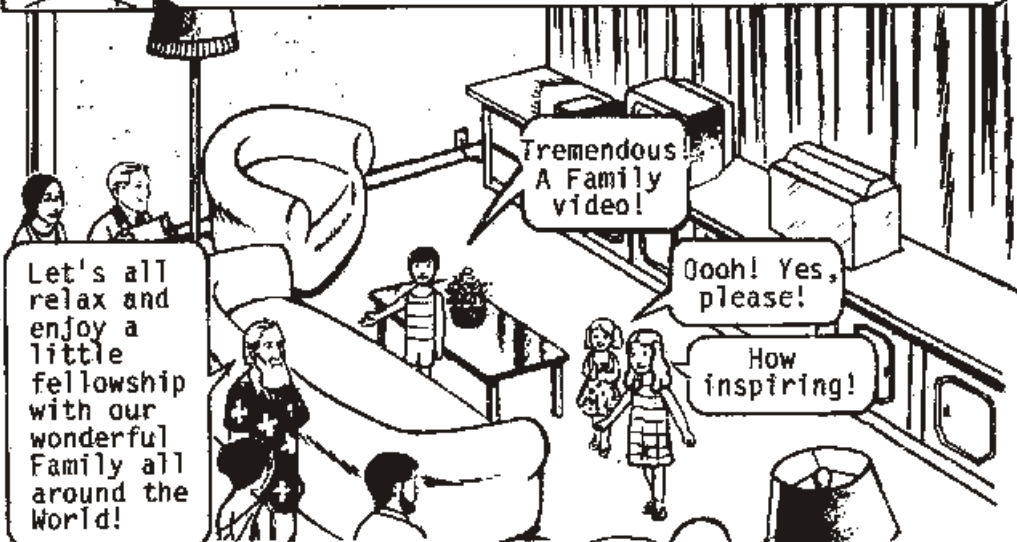


# TONY THE ICEMAN!

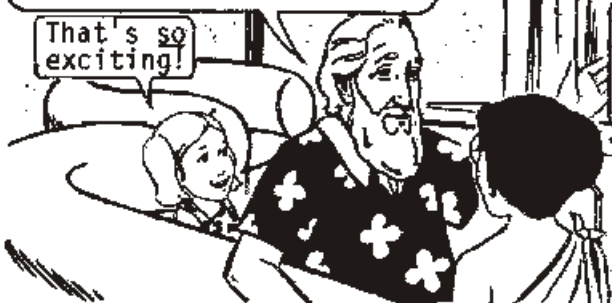


In Jesus' name, free him,

Very well, thank you!

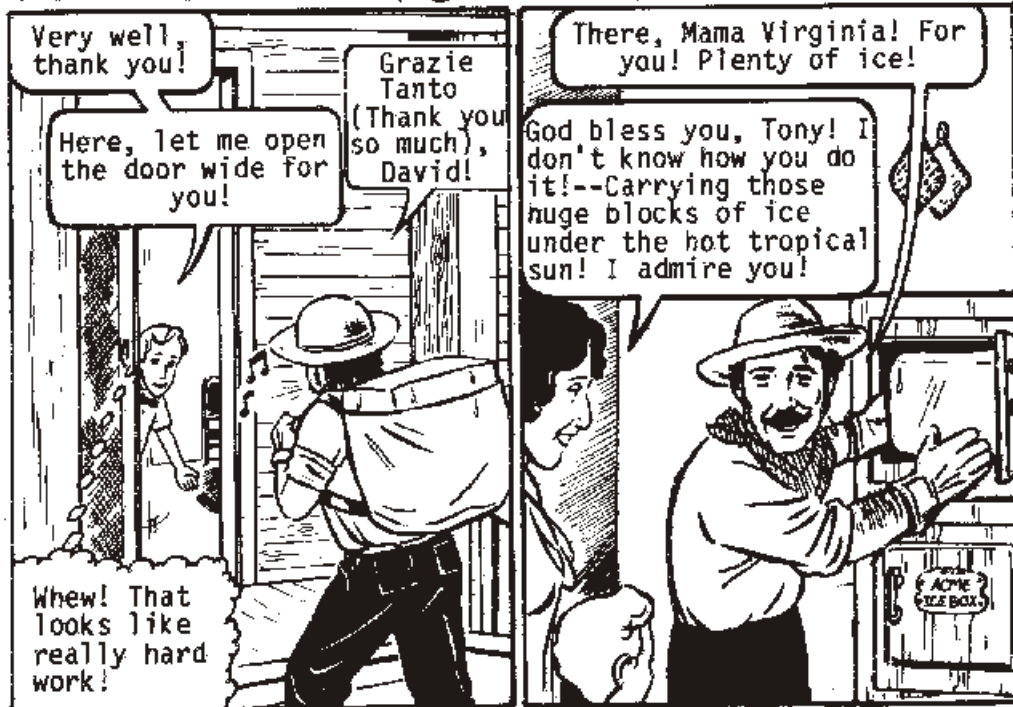
Here, let me open the door wide for you!
