By public transport:

TRAIN

- From Amsterdam Centraal Station take a train (2 per hour, direction Almere) to A'dam Science Park station. This takes 8 minutes. From there it is a 5 minutes' walk to Science Park 107.

TRAM

- Tram line 9 (from Amsterdam Central Station), stop Kruislaan, then walking distance to Science Park about 15 min.;

METRO AND BUS

- From Centraal Station get the metro to Amstel Station;
- From Amstel Station Bus 40, or Bus 240 Stop at Science Park 107, opposite to the Polder restaurant on the left side of the road;
- Entrance to the Building Science Park 107 by The Nikhef Institute for Physics .

- Train tickets can be bought at automatic machines at the airport train station
- Tram/metro/bus tickets can be bought directly on trams and buses.
- To save money, they can be bought also at several shops (including supermarkets)

By car:

- All major roads to Amsterdam lead to the Ring road, the A10;
- Leave the A10 at junction S 113 / Watergraafsmeer / Ring East (ring Oost);
- At the bottom of the exit ramp, choose Watergraafsmeer / Science Park (Middenweg);
- Follow the signs Science Park (Kruislaan);
- After about 1 kilometer, you will find nr. 107;
- You can park your car in the surroundings.
