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Greetings; or should I say *Konicha Wa*, or *salam*, or *kumusta*, or 안녕하세요, or *chào*, or *привет*, or لا ترحيب ه تاف, or 你好, or こんにちは? Whichever way you look at it, Asia is a continent full of diversity. Your task is to explore just how diverse Asia is through choosing one of two tasks that will provide a guide to this diversity with regards to *religion*, *geography* and *tourism*.

Task & Choices

Your task is to **research**, **explore** and **analyse** the diversity of Asia through looking at **religion**, **geography** and **tourism** in Asia. In completing this, your choices are:

1. Produce a **travel brochure** entitled **Amazing Asia** that covers the different aspects of Asia relating to the three categories above (in detail) or
2. Design a plan for **The Amazing Race: Asia** that covers the different aspects of Asia relating to the three categories above (in detail).

Whatever your choice is, your assignment **must include**:

- Between 4-7 **different locations**
- Locations from countries **across the 6 regions of Asia**
- Descriptions and **details** of **different aspects of religion, geography and tourism** in Asia
- A **recommendation** of 1 particular country based on **religion, geography and tourism** (ie. your own personal opinion, as either the author of the brochure or director/host of the TV show, of the best country in Asia to visit based on a combination of these aspects).

Steps

1. Choose your locations (ie. countries, cities) across the 6 regions (go back through your books to help you narrow down your choices).
2. For each location, decide whether you will explore either **religion, geography or tourism** (use work in class on each topic as a starting point).
3. Conduct as much research as possible on your chosen aspects and locations (use work in class as a starting point).
4. Choose your mode of presentation (3Ps- poster, PowerPoint or Prezi) and construct your assignment; **you must keep a record of the sites/sources you access and present a bibliography.**
