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As we've discussed, movies are good, but they are one person's point of view of characters, scenery and other aspects, whereas when you read you begin to formulate these ideas and perceptions for yourself. Well, I'm putting YOU in the Director's chair in this respect, because we are about to take the first steps to produce YOUR OWN Hollywood blockbuster: **DEADLY UNNA- THE MOVIE**.

So, what do you have to do?

Task:

For this assignment you are required produce a **series of casting sheets**, where you must select people to play any five of the main characters in the book; Dumbly and Blacky must be two of the give you pick though. You must select wisely and must pick actors/people that you think will play this character effectively. The people you select can essentially be from any walk of life: an actor, a friend, a Teacher (be VERY careful here!) or anyone else. For each character, you are to explain all of these aspects through **paragraphs** that:

1. Describe the characters personality & characteristics (AS MUCH DETAIL AS POSSIBLE through providing EVIDENCE FROM THE TEXT);
2. Explain why you have chosen the actor/person to play a particular character (eg. physical similarities, roles played previously, etc.);
3. You must ALSO provide a visual representation (picture) of what you perceive the character to look like (the best you can do). You can also include pictures of actors and actresses, but these **must not be your only pictures**.

You are to plan your assignment in your books and present your **casting sheets on A3 or A4** pieces of paper entitled **DEADLY UNNA- THE MOVIE**. Although you will find that characters change over the duration of the text, the information in the first 10 chapters will be enough to complete this assignment. Happy casting!

Remember to use the small questions and sheets that we have completed on the events in chapters 1, 2 and 3 to **justify** your choices for whichever task you pick; your books and folders are **vital** here. You have done the hard work in class and at home, so this should be a chance for all of you to succeed and make this assignment rock!
