Pro Stock Racing have designed, tweaked and packaged up some Ohlins suspension in kits specifically for the Z34 370z. Developed on the track by Nobuteru "Nob" Taniguchi, this gear is available in kits suitable for both the tuned street car and serious circuit racers.

Spring rates vary from 11k front 10k rear in the Ohlins DFV Complete Kit suspension (375,900 yen) to 16k front 14k rear in the PSMS Ohlines DFV SPL version (447,000 yen).
