


The HTC Titan and HTC Radar, which will be running Windows Phone 7 Mango, Which is their latest update of the windows phone 7 OS. Both the radar, and the higher spec titan will be available in europe and asia next month. At launch, they didnt release any information about prices or a specific release date and such.

They're facing troubles in the market as they only own 2.7% of the market with phones that run their operating systems.

Both phones will have a aluminium moulded body like the desire or sensation.

The Radar has a 1GHz processor, 8GB of internal memory and 512MB of RAM. It has a super LCD screen measuring 3.8 inches. Both phones support HSDPA (high-speed downlink packet access) for downloading, with speeds up to 14.4 Mbps. It will also have a 5 mega pixel camera.

The titan will have an 8 Megapixel camera. No other specs have been released

The Mango OS will bring 300 more features too. Expect more mango phones very soon.

Samsung's Flagship Android Phone Is Coming Soon To The US and will be sold by: AT&T, Sprint, and T-Mobile.

You won't be getting the exact same phone from the 3 carriers, which is a shame, but all the different models will all share the same basics, 1.2 GHz Exynos CPU, Android 2.3 Gingerbread and 16 GB of storage.

AT&T and T-Mobile will be calling the device the Samsung Galaxy S II while Sprint will be calling the device the Epic 4G Touch. AT&T's model will have a 4.3-inch Super AMOLED screen and a 1650 mAh battery (and an 8.89 mm profile). The T-Mobile and Sprint models will have a 1800 mAh battery better suited to power a 4.52-inch screen.

The AT&T models will have HSPA+, while the Sprint model will have WiMax. So every model will have 4G.

Sprint will sell the device for \$199.99 beginning Sept. 16. AT&T says their version will hit shelves in the coming weeks. T-Mobile's version will become available this fall.

an evolution of its phone based predecessor, with some added enhancements that take advantage of a tablet's larger screen size,


All this information was provided by a Blog Post by Mozilla.

Not much information has been provided about this browser, but the UI looks alot different from the smartphone version.


Mozilla has not announced a release date yet.

There have been suggestions that the iPhone 5 will have a 4 inch or 4.2 inch screen on it and it would also be edge to edge, however there are now rumors that it will only be a 3.5 or 3.7 inch screen, even though the mock ups show a 4 inch screen.

However if they do take a smaller screen, it means that there will be a thinner bezel around the screen to make it seem bigger.

There are also a lot of different speculations about the iPhone 5's spec. Some have said it will come sporting the 4 inch screen with an 8 megapixel camera, full HD recording, one of Apple's A5 processors and a thinner design, whereas some other places are saying that the changes will be minimal.

We think that you should keep your mind open to all these rumors so you're not disappointed at the end result of it. However I think the minimal tweaks may be about the 4S and the 5 will be a much more powerful and different machine.
