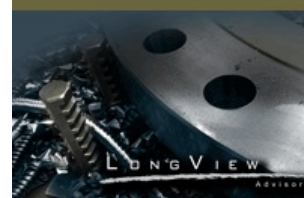
In addition, ample networking time is provided to discuss specific topics with colleagues and experts in the field.
