Lexus LFA

The **Lexus LFA** is a concept supercar which was initially introduced at the 2005 North American International Auto Show (NAIAS), the car was later reworked upon by Toyota's premium brand for slight modifications and was re-launched at Detroit at 2007 North American International Auto Show..

LFA altogether provides a bold new design to Lexus brand and marks the beginning of a new era in supercars . The styling of the LFA is rooted in a design direction called L-finesse, the concept of L-finesse design direction was used to reshape and redefine the 2005 model to give it a more refined look which was earlier presented at 2007 NAIAS. The state of the art version has amend syling and rectification, the front end, in particular is made more curvaceous to administer LFA the sporty look and allow better aerodynamics

Another fascinating enhancement in the LFA is the installation of a prominent, fixed rear wing as compared to the smaller versions in other supercars, the rear wing is bound for giving supercars the required down force at high speeds . Altogether LFA's front engine placement, along with a rear-mounted transaxle and radiators provides an excellent weight distribution; and at the same time the powerful engine, aerodynamics and revised styling enable the car to reach a top speed of 200 mph.

Prior to the release of LFA Lexus had amarket image of assembling top notch, supreme elegant cars, but with its launch the company is trying to change its conception and also targets to propagate its market by manufacturing powerful and beautiful supercars for its customers

Although the LFA is in its prototype, the final production version of LFA cannot be expected around the corner. The pricing of LFA is expected to be \$100,000 or above, at such a price the LFA is truly one of the promising super cars to be produced by a Japanese automaker, and surely the production version of LFA is going to pose big threat for other luxury car manufacturers presently competing with **Lexus LFA**.

Since people put all kinds of stuff on the flat bed truck, sometimes they just have to , the needs for tie downs become pretty complex .

We are going to talk about truck tie down straps exclusively.

Slide in winch and **winch tie downs** are most popular tie down devices for flat beds .

Some flat beds come with winches installed, not all trailers have winches installed . When the flat bed have the winches installed, we can use winch tie down straps to tie down articles on the flat bed , usually we tie down steel coils, concrete pipes, skids, anything that not too heavy for the 5400lbs working load limit . Winch straps usually come with flat hooks, because we usually hook the straps on the edge of the flat bed , of course the wire hook can be used too. We can find 2" and 4" winches and 2" and 4" winch tie downs, depends on different applications , the strap length can be 20', 25', 27', 30', 35', 40' or more than 50' .

And here are most popular tie downs: ratchet strap .

Ratchet tie downs are the most used tie down devices because of their flexibility, you can put them almost anywhere when it's applicable. The ending comes with quite some varieties, flat hooks, wire hooks, chain anchor, snap hooks, endless and more. And it's width can be 1" through 4", length can be a few inches to more than 50 feet. On big rigs ratchet tie downs are the most used tie down devices for haulers, those flat bed trucks without winches installed will figure that ratchet straps are pretty important.

To get these tie down straps, you have the choice between local stores and online , depends on different situation , sometimes get them in local store is more appropriate

, sometimes online deals are much better.

Preparing For Disasters (Tornadoes)

Yesterday, I wrote about some things you could do to prepare for flooding in your area. Today, I want to write about tornadoes. Tornadoes can be far more frightening than floods, but careful preparation can significantly reduce the risk of harm to your family. Your local Chapter of **The American Red Cross** can provide advice more specific to conditions in your area.

It is great to have a home tornado plan if the area you live in experiences tornadoes . Pick a place where family members can gather if a tornado threatens your home. Some safe places may include a basement, a hallway in the center of your house, or even a closet on the lowest floor of the house. If you are caught in a high rise building and don't have enough time to get to the ground floor move to a hallway in the center of the building. It is important to know what the various storm weather warnings mean, and what you should do when you hear them.

A tornado watch means a tornado is possible in your area . When a tornado watch is issued, listen to local radio and tv stations for updates. Be alert to changing weather conditions. Blowing debris or the sound of an approaching tornado (similar to the sound of a freight train) may alert you.

When a tornado warning is issued and you are already inside, move to the safe place you picked as part of your family tornado plan. Move away from windows, and as close to the center of the house as possible. If you are outside the home when the warning is issued get inside as soon as possible. Lay flat in a ditch or low-lying area if you don't have enough time to get to your house . If you are in a mobile home or car, get out of the vehicle and head for a safe area, as outlined above.

After the tornado passes, watch out for fallen power lines and stay out of the damaged area; also, listening to the radio for information and instructions is important ; use a flashlight to inspect your home for damage; and, do not use candles at any time.

Members of The American Red Cross play an important part in emergencies such as tornadoes, both before and after the tornado has passed. Volunteers can provide you with valuable advice at any time regarding preparations for tornadoes, and afterwards they are very visible in recovery efforts. You can help The American Red Cross to continue their important emergency work by **donating a car** or another vehicle. These **donated vehicles** can provide a substantial profit when they are re-sold and will make a real difference in the event of an emergency.
