I also just had a new changeable bezel that I had made and here is the finished product. The cabochon is removeable.

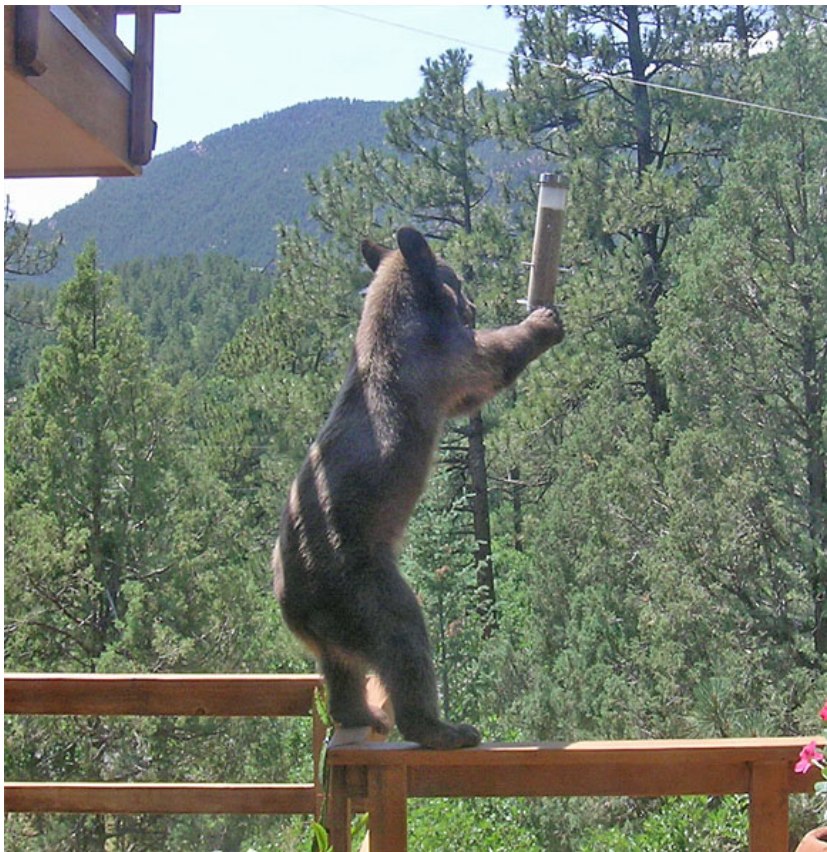

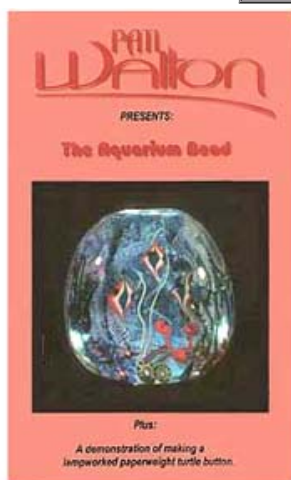
