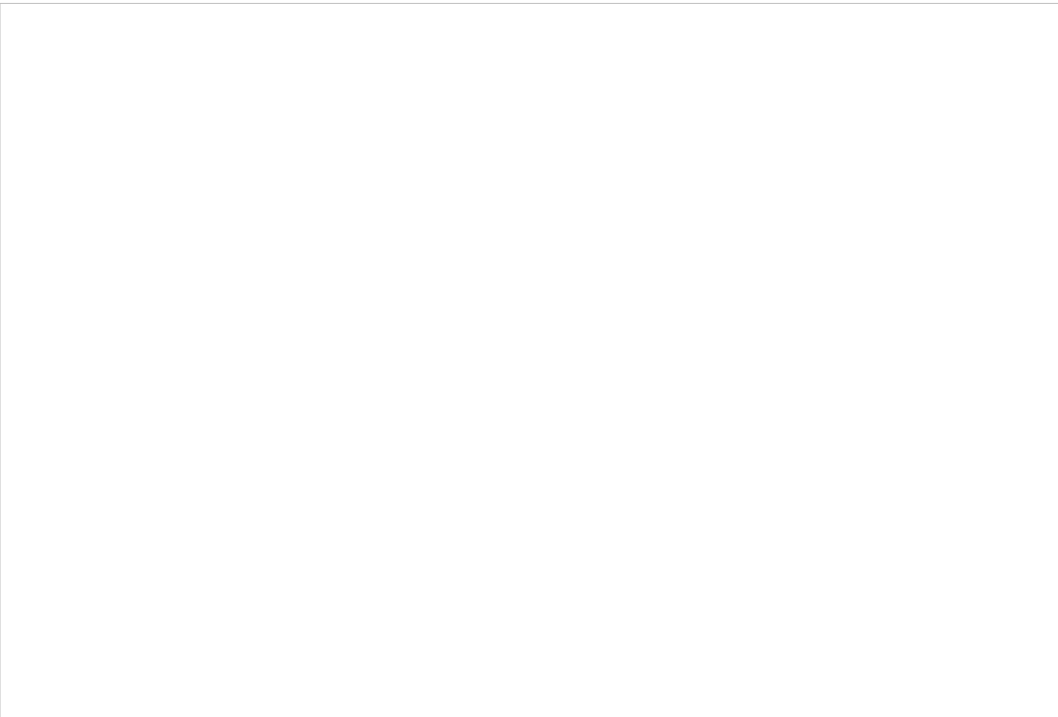
This might be a weird and gruesome post, but its about a moment that was meaningful to me. I slaughtered a chicken in Indonesia. I had wanted to do it ever since I saw people slaughtering in South Africa. Not because I thought I would enjoy to kill an animal, but because I enjoy eating meat, and I have never actually killed an animal, I didnt know what it is like to take an animals life, even though its obviously so crucial to eating meat. I thought I should know what it feels like and if I would be able to do it, if want to keep eating meat. Also, people all over the world have to slaughter for their meat, and dont always buy it from a butcher or a supermarket. Its a part of life and a regular experience. My grandparents and even parents were also used to the process of slaughtering. Nowadays here in Europe though it is easy to become estranged from the crucial process of taking an animals life and from the actual animal when I buy a cut and packaged peace of meat. So together with friends in Indonesia we bought two chickens and under the supervision of an Indonesian friend that had slaughtered before we cut their throats, plugged the feathers, cleaned them and cooked them. And slaughtering was not easy. It was actual manual work and it felt violent. And it definitely did not smell nice. I was shocked when I saw the animal dying. We cooked a curry with the meat, but it did not taste nice. Im not sure if it is because we did not slaughter the animals properly, causing too much stress or if the meat just was not good, or if it was my conscience slightly ruining the meal. I still eat meat though. And I'd do it again.

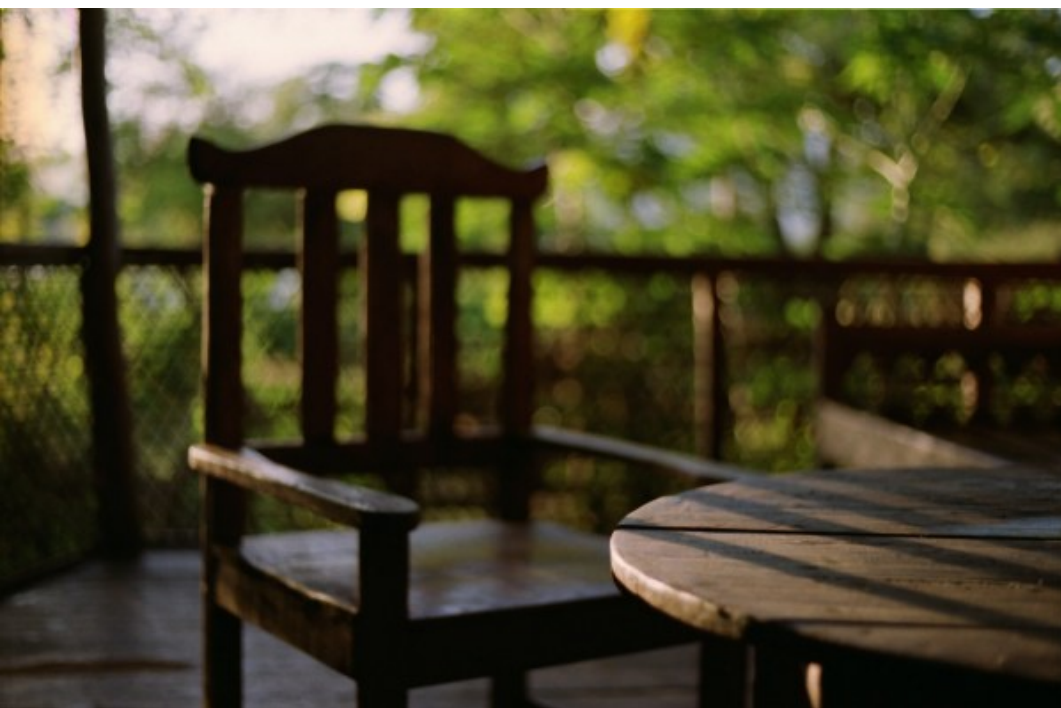


# August 24. Alor

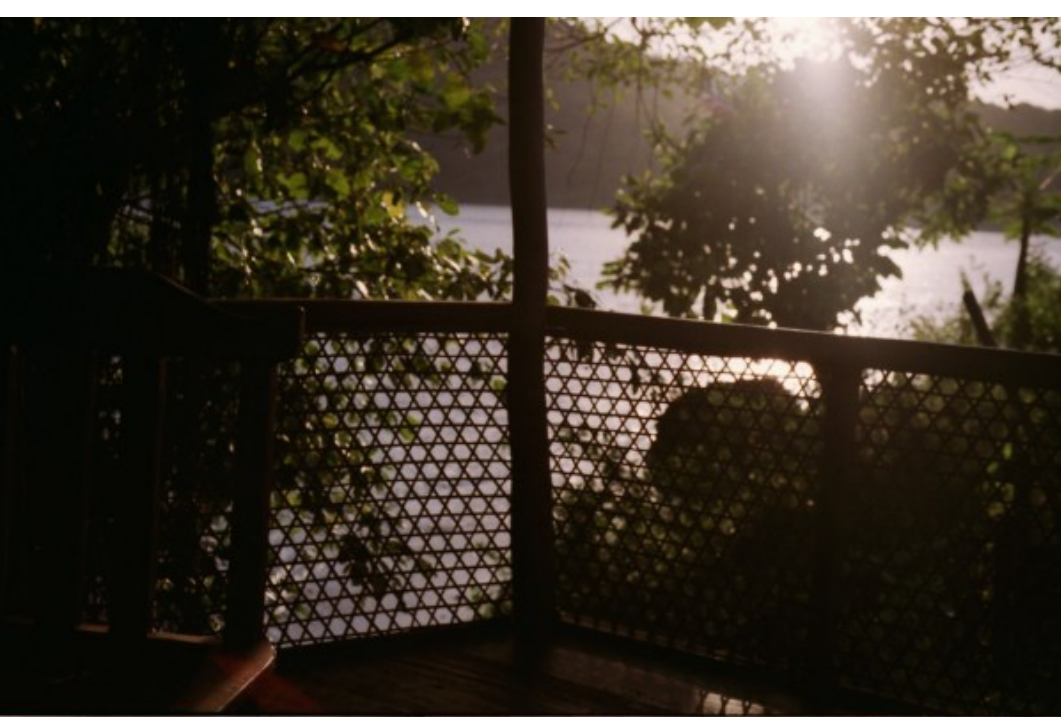

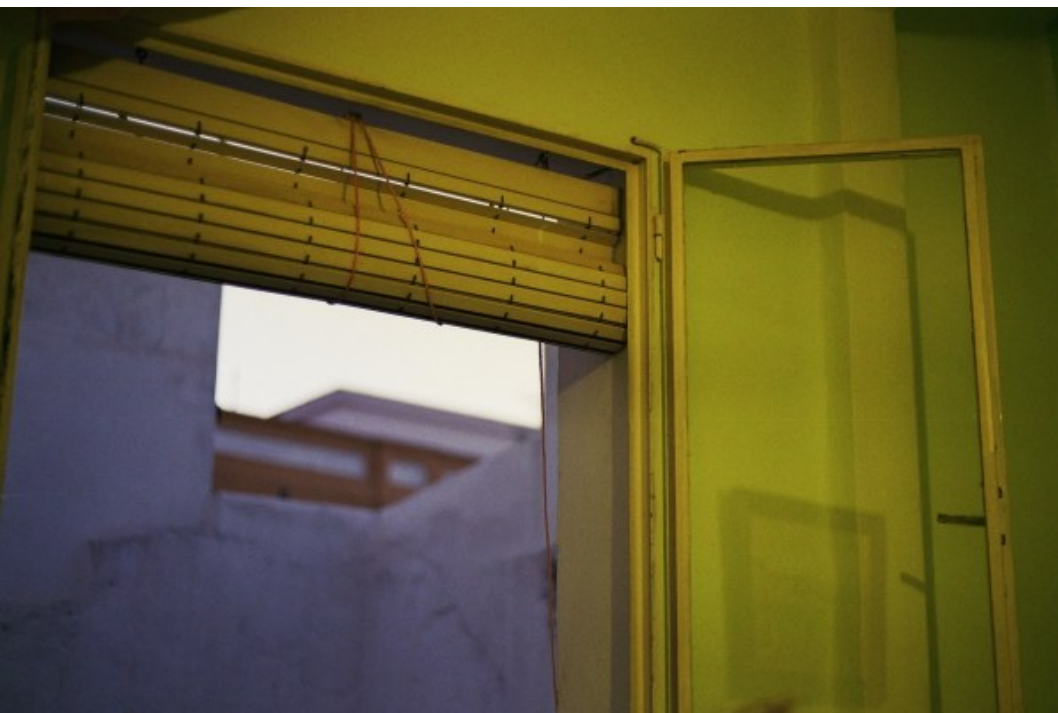

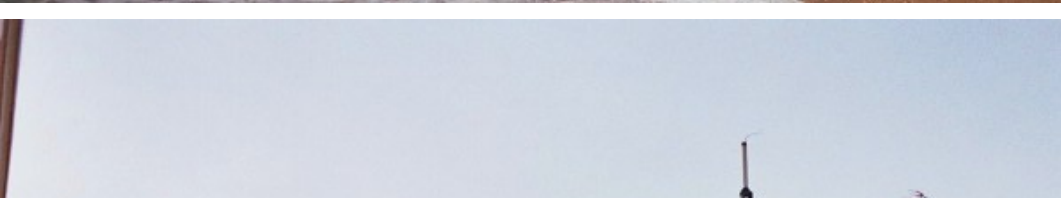
