OLDWICK, N.J. — Buried within U.S. health reform legislation being debated in Congress is a provision to create a government-run long-term care insurance plan the private industry contends would not meet the needs of millions of baby boomers if they need these benefits later, according to BestWeek U.S./Canada. ENGLAND's slumped and grieving masses were offered a dot of hopeyesterday by an illustrious foreign manager, who insists our country has 'goodplayers' even if he doesn't allow them within a 50-mile radius of his own team.

Running a mile from Steve McClaren's old job, Arsene Wenger reminds us thatFrance failed to qualify for the 1994 World Cup and then won it four yearslater amid scenes reminiscent of the Nazis being run out of Paris.

What a thoroughly decent English Frenchman Wenger is. In this week of sorrowand brolly-rage, the Arsenal manager kindly skated round the fact that theFrench had the Clairefontaine academy for a base, while the English haveManchester's Lowry Hotel, or that Les Bleus could summon Zinedine Zidane,whereas England can't even persuade the most naturally gifted midfielder of hisgeneration to play for them.

Paul Scholes' timing in the tackle may suggest a smashed internal clock, butthis red-headed embodiment of what many of us think an English footballersshould look like measured his exit perfectly. We lost one ginger and replacedhim with McClaren.

There are several other reasons why France won both the World and Europeantitles from 1998- 2000, while the Three Lions were being downgraded to a trioof neutered cats. From the top, there were Thierry Henry, Lilian Thuram, FabienBarthez, Marcel Desailly, Patrick Vieira and Emmanuel Petit.

Wenger also neglected to mention that the French national set-up is generallyrun as a professional sporting operation and not as Vanity Fair.

My point in mentioning Wenger's arm round the shoulder of his raddled host isto say that there are five issues English football can confront to loosen thetourniquet of despair.
