



Working Green Tip #7: The airlines produce up to 2% of the world's greenhouse gases, but did you know that IT equipment produces up to 4%? What can you do to help reduce the pollution from computers, printers, phones, PDA's, etc? Recycle old equipment, printer cartridges, batteries, and cell phones by calling the Office of the Building to include it in the next e-waste pick up. And, turn off equipment when not in use and enable power savings settings on all non-critical devices including monitors to turn themselves off after a short duration of activity.
