### 2011: The Year of Release



We at the Borneo Orangutan Survival Foundation (BOSF) enter the first year of the second decade of the 21st century with a renewed sense of optimism and spirit. Since our founding in 1991 the BOSF has rescued and rehabilitated over 1,000 displaced orangutans, victims of the various threats that have brought the species to the brink of extinction. It is our mission to preserve the species through the eventual reintroduction of rescued and rehabilitated orangutans back to their natural habitat, where new populations can propagate and live in relative security and harmony as an integral part of the rainforest ecosystem.


Unfortunately, our efforts to reintroduce orangutans to the wild forests of Borneo have been hampered over the past 9 years by a lack of suitable habitat in which to release them. The international and Indonesian government standards for suitability of habitat are necessarily stringent, designed to ensure that orangutans are not released into areas where they will only again be subjected to further threats and an uncertainty of existence. Through the incredible dedication of the BOSF staff and the generous support of our donors, the habitat problem has now been overcome. We are proud to report that 2011 will be celebrated for the fulfillment of the third- and maybe most important- element of our mission statement, which is to Rescue, Rehabilitate and.....Release.


