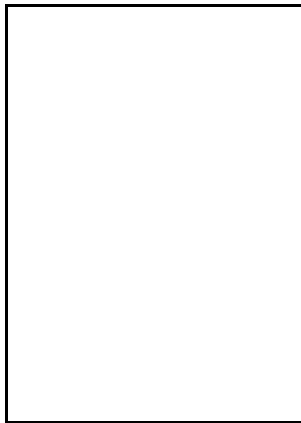

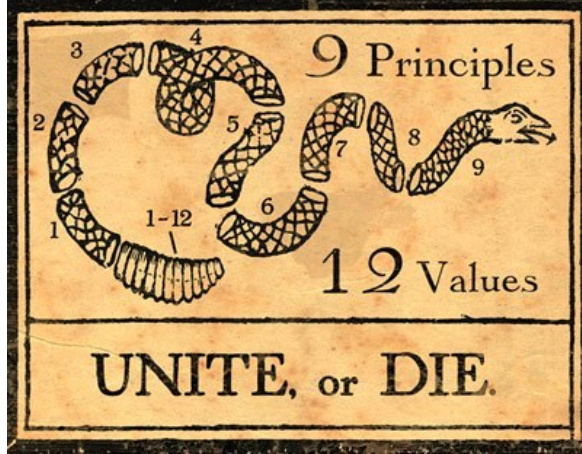
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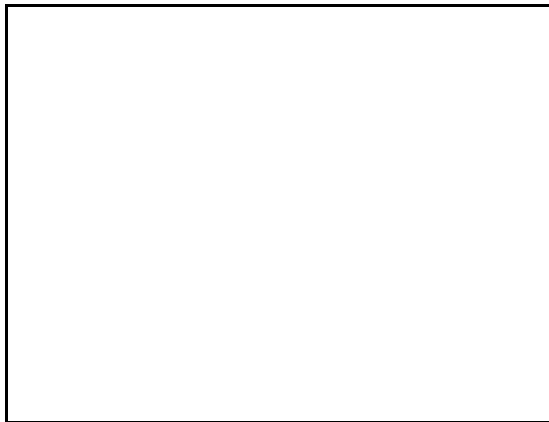

Today in America, more than half of the jobs are now public sector. As we sit now I can understand the "I got mine" and the hell with you attitude that is human nature. But lets look at this for a minute. We have this ponzi scheme of social security and such. A ponzi scheme only works if you have more and more people signing up. So where are the new people that are suppose to be keeping the bottom of the pyramid full?
