Top 3 LCD HDTV Models As of August 2009 (50-Inches and Above)

Samsung LN52B750 52-inch LCD HDTV: Samsung in recent years have revamped themselves to be a leading manufacturer of high-quality consumer electronics. The Samsung LN52B750 is by far one of the best LCD models of 2009. It is a full features HDTV, with online content streaming features, and great picture quality. It has a 240Hz refresher rate that greatly improves the viewing experience of fast moving sequences.

The black levels on this model are thus far the darkest found on any LCD models. The colors were accurate and there was good uniformity across the screen. As this model has some of the latest tech features in the market, it costs a little more than usual. I personally feel that it will be worth every penny spent. The Samsung LN52B750 sports a gray/black minimalist design that is extremely stylish.



Sony BRAVIA KDL-52XBR9 52-inch LCD HDTV: Although this Sony model does not match up to the Samsung LN52B750 in terms of performance and design, it is still a commendable LCD HDTV model. Like most models in this range, the Sony KDL-52XBR9 has a 240Hz refresher rate and online video streaming capabilities. While some of the standard ports and connectors are located on the back of the unit, many are located on the side of the LCD, where they can be accessed more conveniently.

If the ports behind the unit are insufficient for your permanent connections, you can plug them on the side ports as they would not be visible when viewed from the front. It has a thin bezel/frame around the screen that helps make the LCD look bigger than it actually is. The blacks were dark and the colors were generally pretty

accurate. There were some uniformity issues, but a casual user will barely notice it.



Samsung LN55B650 55-inch LCD HDTV: This model sports a more adventurous design, as part of the Red Touch of Color series. Generally black, the Samsung LN55B650 has a hint of dark red below the screen. Nevertheless, it still manages to be extremely stylish despite the design risk. Despite being the mid-range model in the Samsung range, the Samsung LN55B650 outperforms many other competing models in the market. The picture quality is generally good, with accurate colors and good black levels. It also has an extensive feature set.

[Why LCD TVs Emerge As the Winning Choice](#)

When you are sure that all you want is a flat screen TV but unsure about which type to get, then the following information is the first thing you need. Here is a comparison of the two most wanted flat screen televisions of today. See which one is better for your home.

Millions of multihued cells that are filled with gas comprise a Plasma television. It produces pictures once the colorful gas-cells light up because of electrical energy. The common screen width for Plasma TVs is 3 inches to 4 inches thick. The screen size ranges from 40 inches to 65 inches wide. This is the next best thing to a regular cathode ray tube or CRT television. It has brighter and crisper images in an absolutely flat screen. Plasma TV is home entertainment without the blur and the bulk. Their advanced image resolutions are undeniably better. Some reviews even claim that pictures are very clear that it almost look real.

Liquid Crystal Display or LCD TV, conversely, has become even more popular than the good Plasma TV. In between binary glass plates are thin layers of liquid crystals. LCD TV produces images when electrical charge passes through the crystals allowing numerous multicolored pixels to light up. Screens from this kind of television range from 19 inches to 70 inches wide. Thickness varies from ¼ inch to 2 inches.

Their screens are relatively thinner and lighter than Plasma televisions. Most computer game fanatics choose an LCD TV over Plasma television because an LCD TV can be used as computer monitor replacement.

So which among the two is really better? In terms of picture quality, Plasma TV used to give brighter and crisper images. But LCD TV manufacturers were able to catch up and improve the LCD TV's image quality. With the recent models of LCD TV and Plasma TV, you can hardly tell the picture quality difference.

When we talk about viewing angle, Plasma TV again used to have better angle of viewing than the newer LCD TV. Some reviews claim that you can still get a clear view from a Plasma TV even when you sit at different angles from the TV. However, manufacturers such as Samsung are making their LCD television models even better.

LCD televisions seem to provide more entertainment hours before the unit display faded and blurry pictures. LCD televisions like those from Samsung have an approximated 60,000 hours at the very least Plasma TVs on the other hand have a range of 30,000 to 60,000 hours. When it comes to portability, LCD TV earns a point. They are less bulky and lighter than Plasma TV, making them easier to move, carry around, or transfer locations.

Moreover, Plasma TVs are susceptible to burn-ins. This is when images start to be “burned” onto the screen. When you turn the Plasma television off, blurry or ghostly images appear on your screen. For Samsung LCD TVs, this will never be a problem.

In terms of High Definition technology capacity, both seems to have equal points. Plasma TVs and LCD TVs are both HDTV ready. They can provide sharper and more vivid images like three dimensional pictures. Nonetheless, LCD TVs are made to have more display pixels, or higher resolution, than Plasma TVs.

Actually, both Plasma and LCD televisions can be used for video game playing. But because of Plasma television’s burn in problems, LCD appears to be more suitable for computer gaming.

The buyer’s budget should be considered when considering the unit’s price. It also depends on what the consumer is looking for. If you want a simple flat screen where you can enjoy simple home entertainment, a Plasma TV would do. But if you plan to use the television for gaming, then an LCD TV would be a better choice.

Because of the growing demand, they are both priced less expensive now. Online stores and local shops also offer discounts and price cuts. However, some experts claim that you can get a better deal from an LCD TV because it helps you save long term. You may spend a little extra on your initial purchase, but the LCD technology will save you more cash because of its extremely low power consumption.
