Sony Ericsson K770 - The Cyber Power

Sony Ericsson K770 is an easy to handle cyber-shot phone with loads of features. The bar shape slim phone with sleek design attracts attention because of its handy features and compact and solid looks. Solid doesn't mean that the phone is made of steel, the casing is made of plastic but it is not flashy and shiny like some others in the market these days. The compact Sony Ericsson k770 measures 105 x 47 X 14. 5 millimetre which fits in to your hands perfectly. It weighs only 95 grams because of its plastic body making it easy for the user to slide it in the jeans pocket or the handbag. It is available in three non flashy colours- Truffle Brown, Ultra Violet and the recently added Sandy Beige. Obviously a cyber-shot phone can never come without a camera so Sony Ericsson K770 is geared with a 3 megapixel camera. But that's not it as it also has a LED flash, auto focus and dedicated quick camera settings keys so from this angle the phone is perfectly excellent. Now let's see the phone from the eyes of music buffs, the phone has a walkman style music player some phone have made their place in the market only because of this single quality. It has stereo Bluetooth and Bluetooth with A2DP so that the user can enjoy the music comfortably through the wireless headset. For the people who are crazy about the FM the Sony Ericsson K770 also features FM radio so that you don't miss your news and music on the FM. And if that is not enough the phone also has a slot for the microSD card so that the user can store all its images

and songs he wants on it. The phone also has a MP3/MPEG4 player. The Sony Ericsson offers a 1.9 diagonal display.

Now let's see what it's like on the slim bar phone, Apart from the display the front side has video calls camera which is being fixed in the right side. The speaker is visible on the centre of the phone. Sony Ericsson has done certain changes in Keypad, the joystick is replaced by the a comfortable D pad and other keys are also big enough to avoid any kind of confusion or mistakes while dialling. The back of the phone obviously like every phone there is a camera on the upper side along with the LED flash and mirror. And thank heavens the camera also has a protective lens cover to save it from getting damaged. The loudspeaker grill is located at the bottom of the back side is the loudspeaker grill which is also usual, The backside also has Sony Ericsson logo. The left edge of the handset has fast port for attaching the chargers and other peripherals which has become a common feature in Sony Ericsson sets these days. The top edges features the On and Off key which is although not blend seamlessly in the design of the phone but is too small to be pressed accidentally. The bottom edge also has a sliding release key to open the back cover. The left edge of the phone features a dual volume key and a Camera shutter key which unlike the on/off key blend seamlessly in the design of the phone. But the Sony Ericsson K770 also has some disadvantages like it has no EDGE. It's camera is nice and all but it records video in the ancient QCIF (176 x 144 pixels) resolution only. It has place for MicroSD memory slot but its internal memory is just 16 MB. It has Led flash but not Xenon one also there is no BestPic shooting mode.

★ **Motorola KRZR K3 - Hello Moto**

The Motorola's MOTOKRZR K3 is an ultimate style statement. The phone's sleek casing is made of high class stainless steel and glass which gives it that non-plastic, no nonsense look. It comes in two smart and sophisticated stone gray and dark pearl gray shades. The MOTOKRZR K3 measures 103X42X16 millimeter although a bit larger than other models of similar versions but that hasn't harmed its image. It weighs only 110

grams because of the steel used in its body but who will want to carry this phone in pocket anyways. The phone deserved to be flashed, show some respect to a good looking machine guys, umm.. at least until you get a better looking one. Let's analyse its features from the point of view of a person who loves to take pictures. The MOTOKRZR K3 is laced with a 2 megapixel camera with 8x zoom which is decent enough. It also has a VGA camera for a two way video calling, obviously the person you are calling should have the phone with similar features. The MOTOKRZR K3 can also take out the pictures taken by the phone easily as it enables the user to send the images to a compatible Bluetooth® enabled printer to print high-quality pictures. Now lets see what it has got for music lovers: The phone has no fuss external music player controls for that uncomplicated music learning experience. It is laced with 50 megabytes of end user memory and additional space for a hot swappable microSD card, users can store hundreds favourite songs. It also has Bluetooth with A2DP profile which will enable the user to listen the music on the wireless stereo headset. But for the people who love FM Radio it is a little disappointing. We don't know why Motorola couldn't find the space for FM in that bigger frame. The front plate of the flap open phone is obviously by steel surface and the covering glass which is highly prone to fingerprint marks so carry a handkerchief in other hand. The Motorola KRZR K3 has a 910 mAh capacity battery which will be visible when you remove the bi battery cover on the back of the phone with the help of the special release key. The battery provides 180 minutes of talk time and 340 hours of stand by time. The back of the phone also has a space for the SIM card and the microSD card. The back also has a speaker. The phone also has a Motorola trademark chin which is borrowed by others as well.

The edges of the Motorola KRZR K3 are covered with plastics! Why ?? Well the left edge of the phone has dual volume control key and the "smart key" and the right side features the camera release button.

★ **Nokia N76 Review - You dare to miss this**

customers of Nokia N76 are obviously the fashion conscious people as Nokia has given more attention to the looks in the phone than anything else. It does not mean that N76 is totally on the losing side where the features are concerned. It is fitted with decent and some very good features but don't expect to be super phone which will have every quality you want. As we said that the phone is made for fashion conscious people not only for fashion conscious men or only fashion conscious women. Its sleek black metallic cum plastic casing will be proffered by men and the women will love to hold that red slim casing in their hand. Obviously there is always scope for exceptions. It seems Nokia has launched the N76 as an answer to Motorola RAZR, at least its design indicates that.

The Nokia N76 measures 106.5 x 52 millimetres and weighs 115 grams. Although it is comparatively larger than the other flat flip-open phones but its slimness makes up for its size, as it is only 13.7 millimetre thick. But one question we want to ask Nokia is why they used plastic in the casing instead of steel when they were making a good looking phone. The plastic casing in the handset doesn't deserve the cost Nokia is charging for the phone, that is \$500. Also the casing is so shiny that the user had to carry a handset in one phone and a piece of cloth in order to clean the fingerprints every now and then. The Nokia N75 features a TFT external display but it's close to useless under the sunlight. It also displays 262K colours on a resolution of 128X160 pixels. The phone also features an FM radio for the music lovers which is controlled by the three keys below the external display so you don't have to open your phone to control the FM every now and then. The phone runs on a 700 mAh battery of moderate capacity which

provides 165 minutes of talk time and 204 hours of talk time. It is laced with a 2 megapixel camera but its lens are unprotected lens. It also has a flash LED for a better picture taking experience. It is situated above the battery cover. The keypad is little uncomfortable because of its flat keys. It is made for the people who have all the time in the world to type a message or dial a number from the phone. If the user is in a hurry and will want to dial a number in a hurry it is quite a possibility that he will dial wrong numbers, as his finger will also hit the adjoining keys as well. The flat keypad also makes it difficult to play games on the phone. The phone features a 1GB memory cards with a slot for microSD card, Nokia has also thrown in an additional 256MB card with the package. The Nokia N75 has only 26 MB internal memory. The phone is extremely susceptible to fingerprints and its joint toughness makes opening a bit difficult and unstylish.

Its switch-off button is unreachable when the phone is open also the phone does not open full if earphones or data cable is plugged in. It does not feature Wi-Fi or HSDPA.

Also its camera image quality is below average. Its music player constantly runs in background which is not satisfying at all and on top of that its Bluetooth does not support A2DP profile.

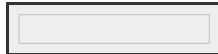

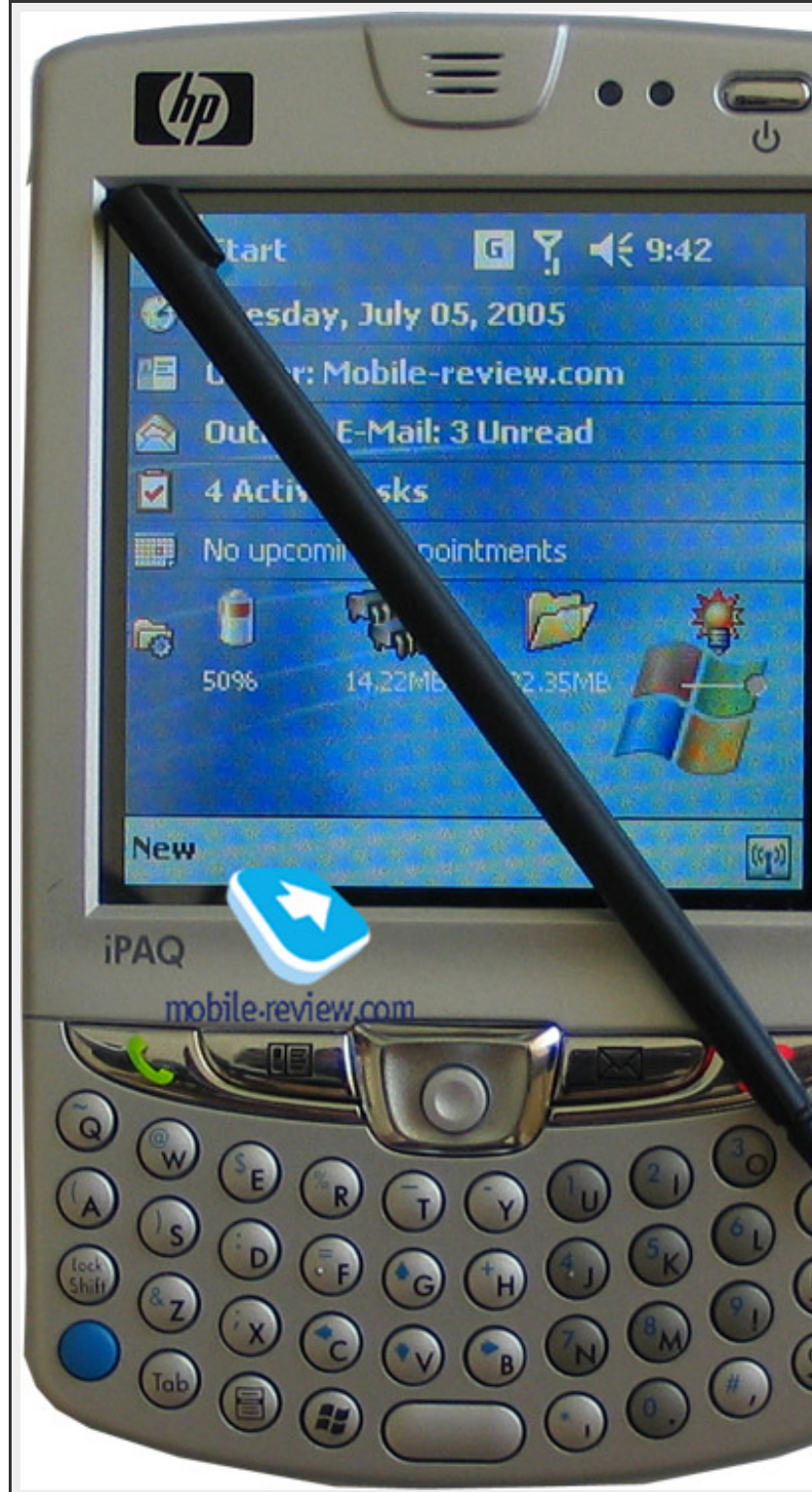
The latest Treo 500v is Palms attempt to save a position for itself in the market. The new Palm phone is coming in the market after a long break. Let's see if Plam's innovative team was working hard during this long break or was just having a break. The Palm Treo 500v is available in two colour schemes - grey/silver and white/silver is a Vodafone exclusive, hence given away free with some Vaodafone contracts. The sleek and slim casing with no edges is much more appealing then its Treo predecessors. The Palm Treo 500v measures 110x 61.5x 16.5millimeters (4.3" x 2.4" x .65") and considering its loads of features it weighs just 120 grams. The phone features a QWERTY keyboard and a decent sized screen the phone look pretty stylish. But the size of the keys can be a problem for some as there is always a risk of accidentally giving a command which the user not intended to give. But it seems that the mobile phone makers have not been able to find a solution for this problem. If they concentrate on the size and the shape of the phone the keys get smaller and if they concentrate on the keys the phone gets bulky and ugly. Some will argue that touch screen is already a solution but they will also agree that it gets dicey sometimes as well. It is laced with bright and clear 320x240 pixel screen which is not scared of sunlight. It features strong backlight which illuminates the

entire keyboard. Right below the screen there is an Oval 'D' pad, four flush buttons and the call receiving and ending buttons. The controls buttons are responsive and are comfortable as they are not small like rest of the keys on the keyboard. Laced with a 2megapixel camera a user replaceable Li-ion 1200MaH battery sitting tightly inside with the SIM and miniSD card slots lurking below the Treo 500v might fulfil the purpose it was launched with. You know we are not talking about the users.

★ HP iPAQ hw6515 - A Sober Gadget

HP's iPAQ hw6515 is an innovation in a communicator's arena because of its slim casing. A communicator has never been so thin and sleek but its main attraction is not slimness but a thumbboard. The phone is totally opposite to what its predecessors looked like, iPAQ hw6300 series, with 118 x 71 x 21 millimeter casing and 165 grams weight you will doubt it of being a communicator. But this baby has all the qualities. Let's see the first thing that strikes you is its 65K colour touch screen with its 240 x 240 pixel resolution, marking the very first

Windows Mobile based device with a square screen to hit shelves. And have no doubt as it is bright, clear and with adequate ClearType performance. On the upper right corner of the casing place has been made for the power on/off button alongside to unobtrusive alert LEDs. Right below the screen there is a five-way navigational pad just flanked by dual-purpose, mappable hard and rather very small buttons for opening the contacts and e-mail applications. These are followed by large and comfortable call and end telephony hard buttons on either side, and in the upper right corner resides the power on/off button alongside to unobtrusive alert LEDs. The HPiPAQ hw6515 features an integrated thumbboard, EDGE, Bluetooth and GPS. But don't expect much from the thumbboard , it seems that HP has put it there for the sake of proving their point that it can be done but its not at all comfortable.

Some of the buttons positions have been changed to make it uncomfortable and they are again very small to operate. It is quite possible and we think that it will happen often that the user of the HPiPAQ hw6515 will press two commands at a time, all because of extra small buttons to fit in that ultra small and thin casing. The only control which is easy operate to operate is volume up/down rocker far up on the left side of the phone but its that easy that you can switch it on accidentally. The communicator is also laced with a 1.3 Megapixel camera, 1,200 mAh Lithium Ion battery integrated GPS receiver, an 312 MHz Intel PXA270 processor backed up by 44 MB of volatile memory and 12 MB of non-volatile memory, EDGE.

Sony Ericsson W880 is the new super ultra slim walkman phone. Scores of features in the in the ultra phone may force you to doubt our truthfulness. But trust Sony Ericsson made it possible to adjust these features in that slim bar. Only 9.44 millimeter walkman phone by Sony Ericsson is laced with the walkman 2.0 music player. For those who love music it also features TrackID music service and Bluetooth with A2DP players. Sony Ericsson also provides a headset with a standard 3.5 millimeter audio adapter. Sony Ericsson also managed to fit in a 2 Megapixel the camera in that Slim casing so for all those who think that a slim shell like that can not accommodate camera you are wrong. It has one GB memory and a M2 Memory card slot with hot swap functionality so dearth of memory space as well in the compact phone. There is also facility of 3G support with video calls but it records video in ancient QCIF (176 x 144 pixels) resolution only. Hey you should praise the fact that they managed to fit in the video camera there. But they have made a compromise which we think should have avoided that is the phone have no FM. A walkman phone with out FM sounds like a music composer without his

musical instruments. Its camera also lacks auto focus and no EDGE.

The mineral glass also gives the screen a wider look and improves viewing angle of the screen up to 170 degrees. The best part is the animation effect on the screen sets off waves of light around the keypad. It is fitted with an excellent 3.2 megapixel camera with auto focus. The 1.9 inch scratch proof screen gives you excellent display of the picture you have taken. It is also laced with the LED flash for that ultimate photography experience. The Sony Ericsson T650 also enables the user to send his his or her pictures to his

friends and family by attaching it to an email or on the Web using picture blogging. Being an all rounder phone it also has an excellent offering for the music lovers. It has FM radio and music player got the music lovers delight but wait the main thing is still left. It has a Bluetooth enabled headset, which means it can directly stream music from the handset. The headset without wires, HBH-DS980, is obviously a much more comfortable and better music listening experience. And for those who are thinking that the phone will be heavy because of metal casing stop bothering as the phone is all plastic inside making it light weight. The 12.5 millimeter Sony Ericsson T650 is easy to carry in pocket and handbag because of its weight and compact size. It's a thin 3G phone which works nets UMTS 2100, GSM/GPRS 900/1800/1900.

Lets analyse the edges of the Sony Ericsson T650..

The top edge of the T650 sports only on and off key and a sliding key to open the back cover of the phone. The bottom edge of the T650 only has a microphone pin hole and holes for attaching a neck string or hand strap (you will have to remove the back cover to attach the string or strap). The right side contains the obviously a port for the charger, a recently introduced feature in a Sony Ericsson handset. The left side features the dual volume key and control button for camera shutter. They are blended in the design of the phone seamlessly to give it sleek and smooth look. Going to the rear back, it has camera and led flash but the camera is not made to fit seamlessly in the casing which not only spoils the smooth look of the handset but can also expose its lenses prone to scratching. The black frame of the camera also spoils the looks of the handset. The loudspeaker grill is placed at the bottom of the rear panel.
