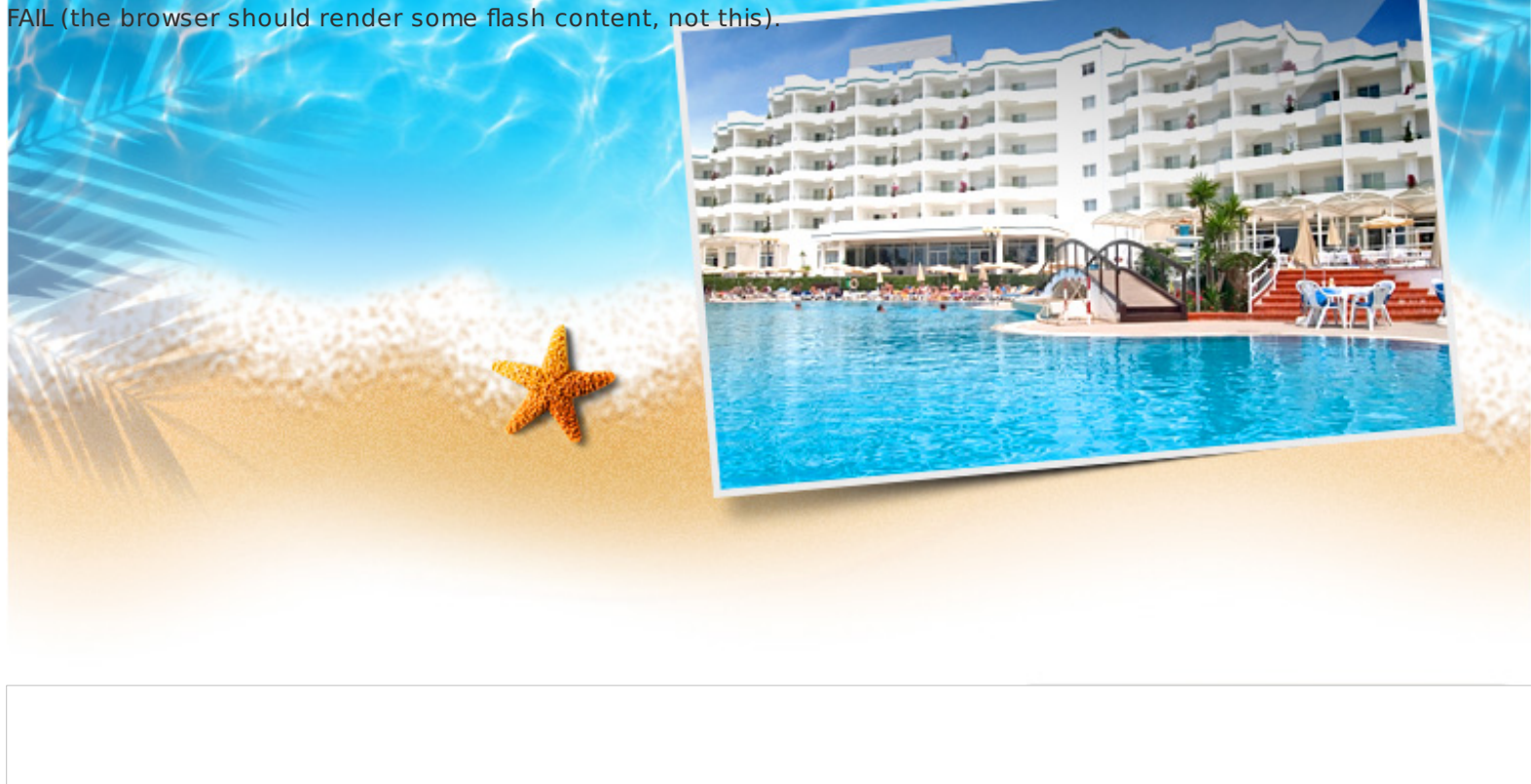

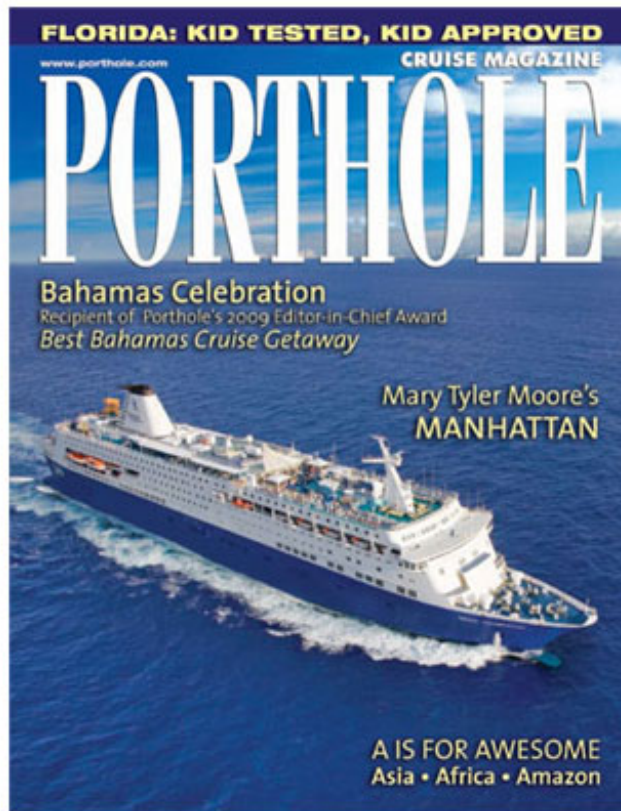
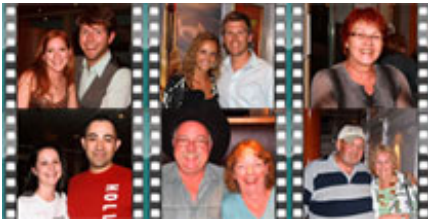

### **Great News!**

U.S. citizens will not need passports to travel on our cruise!

Recent guidance received from the Department of Homeland Security indicates that U.S. citizens taking our Bahamas and Mexico cruises are **not required to have a passport**, but will need proof of citizenship such as an original or certified copy of a birth certificate, a certificate of naturalization, or a passport card, **TOGETHER WITH** a government-issued photo ID.

Children are also required to bring proof of citizenship, and if 16 and over, a photo ID is also required. Passports are required only for US citizens who debark the ship for an extended hotel stay in the Bahamas or Mexico and return at a later date.
