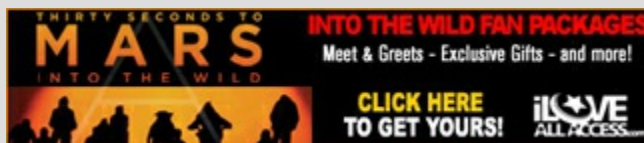

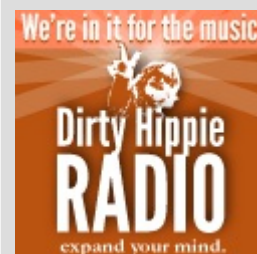


Oklahoma Daily:

In response to an overwhelming demand for tickets, 5FM, MNET and Big Concerts are excited to announce that Thirty Seconds to Mars will be performing not one but two concerts in Cape Town, later this year. The additional performance is scheduled to take place at Grand Area, GrandWest on Saturday the 20th November 2010.

Thirty Seconds to Mars are a world class arena crushing rock trio featuring Jared Leto on lead vocals/guitar, Shannon Leto on drums and Tomo Milicevic on guitar. Together they have sold over 3.5 million albums worldwide and have been viewed over 100 million times on youtube.

In 2002 they released their self titled debut album. This was followed by 'A Beautiful Lie' (2005) which produced two Top 5 Modern Rock singles in 'From Yesterday' and 'The Kill' which set a record for the longest running hit in the history of Modern Rock radio when it remained on the national airplay chart for more than 50 weeks following its No. 3 peak in 2006.

Their latest release 'This is War' (2009) has been called their strongest and most accomplished work to date. For this they enlisted two of the most influential producers in the world: Flood (U2, Nine Inch Nails, Depeche Mode, Smashing Pumpkins) and Steve Lillywhite (U2, Rolling Stone, Peter Dinklage) who gave the band freedom and confidence to explore different sound, textures and ideas. The album represents the result of an 18 month creative battle, fought ferociously, but privately inside a studio in the Hollywood Hills. The result: a triumphant sound

Thirty Seconds to Mars have won numerous awards including an MTV Music Video Award, three MTV EMA's, MTV Latin, Asia and Australia Awards, a Fuse Award and three Kerrang! Awards. The band have played over 500 shows around the world including Lollapalooza in the U.S, Download in the UK, Germany's Rock Am Ring, Japans Summer Sonic and South Africa's My Coke Fest. The response from the fans in South Africa in 2008 was unforgettable and the band excited to be back headlining their own tour.

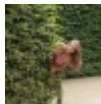

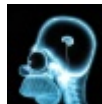

MTV Epicenter Concert Review

Epicenter’s ability to stage full production throughout the weekend for everyone from Bush and Eminem to KISS and 30 Seconds to Mars was impressive, considering the difficulty accommodating so many different headline-caliber acts. Recent VMA winners 30 Seconds to Mars followed Bad Religion on the main stage, which they decorated with a large version of their triangular symbol.

A photographer who shot the band described their set as an “estrogen fest,” due to the strong and vocal contingent of females who clearly admired frontman Jared Leto’s looks at least partly as much as his singing. The band chose its most anthemic tracks for Epicenter, belting out rousing renditions of “This Is War,” “Night of the Hunter” and “A Beautiful Lie” with Leto and the two other permanent members of the band — guitarist/keyboardist Tomo Milicevic and Jared’s brother, drummer Shannon — firing on all cylinders.

Sporting a white leather jacket (which quickly came off), black sleeveless shirt, red fingerless gloves and bleach-blond hair reminiscent of his Angel Face role in “Fight Club,” Jared Leto led the crowd through an incredible sing-along during “The Kill,” starting the song off acoustically, by himself, and ending up standing atop the barricade as the rest of the band backed him with electric power.

His good-natured interaction with the crowd was constant: At one point, he demanded one of the venue’s large water hoses and proceeded to personally douse the crowd, which welcomed the relief from the heat. The band filled the stage with people

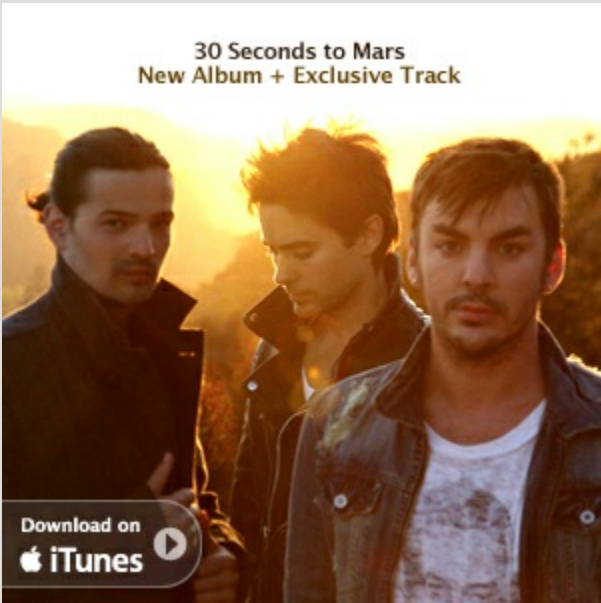

‘It’s a very ambitious project,’ says frontman Jared Leto. What else can Leto tell us about the video? Well, since he’s still planning it, there’s not a whole lot more he’s willing to reveal, but he does have a concept that he’s more than happy to discuss. A dirty, dangerous one.

” ‘Hurricane’ as a video, like I said before, is going to be very, very sexual,” he said. “It’s basically a meditation on the violence of sex, and the sex of violence ... and it’s going to be quite an adventure.”

It sure sounds that way. Of course, there’s still a long way to go before the band even starts shooting the clip — trying to schedule the thing in-between dates on their Into the Wild Tour is proving to be quite the challenge — but Leto is determined not only to get it done, but to make sure it lives up to the rather epic standard of the band’s earlier videos, including the VMA-winning “Kings and Queens” and the soul-saving “Closer to the Edge.”

And while the stress of pre-production has left his voice a little ragged (that and the singing), Leto says not to worry: Not only will “Hurricane” happen, it’s going to be the kind of video 30 STM fans have come to expect from the band: very, very big.

“We’re in the midst of plotting and planning right now ...

on This Is War, more than a few eyebrows were raised when Kanye West posted a photo on his blog of him, Jared Leto and the Killers' Brandon Flowers in the studio, where the trio had apparently just finished recording a "dope-ass song."

Later, Leto explained to MTV News that the "dope-ass song" was called "Hurricane," and it featured West singing, minus the Auto-Tune he'd been dabbling with at the time (there was no mention of Flowers' involvement). It sounded like a promising collaboration, but, sadly, fans never actually got to hear it: When This Is War hit stores, "Hurricane" was on there, but West's work wasn't.

Leto explained that the band had to remove Kanye from the track at the last minute, due to some rather restrictive deadlines and a lot of back-and-forth between record labels, but he and his 30STM mates were so impressed with West's contributions that they pledged that someday, somehow, the song would see the light of day.

And, as it turns out, they kept their promise. On November 2, 30STM will release a deluxe edition of This Is War, featuring a DVD, a pair of live tracks recorded for the BBC (including a version of Lady Gaga's "Bad Romance") and, at long last, the full, Kanye West-ified version of "Hurricane." It's been a long time in the making, but, as Leto told MTV News on Friday (September 24), the song is worth the wait.
